The Town of Markham Aquatic Club (MAC) wants to repeat as the Ontario AA champion, and has hired a new coach to aid it along the way.

Twenty-six-year-old Bernie Bredschneider took up his duties with MAC last month. He replaced George Smith, who's moved into missionary work after seven years with MAC.

Bredschneider has several degrees plus a level 2 coaching diploma. He was a competitive swimmer

for almost 16 years, earning a spot on two Commonwealth games teams, two world championship teams and Canada's 1980 Olympic squad.

Before coming to MAC Bredschneider served as head coach at the York Aquatic Club for 2½ years. His long-range goals for MAC include developing Olympic games or world championship finalists and medalists. He's also like to qualify for either event as a coach.

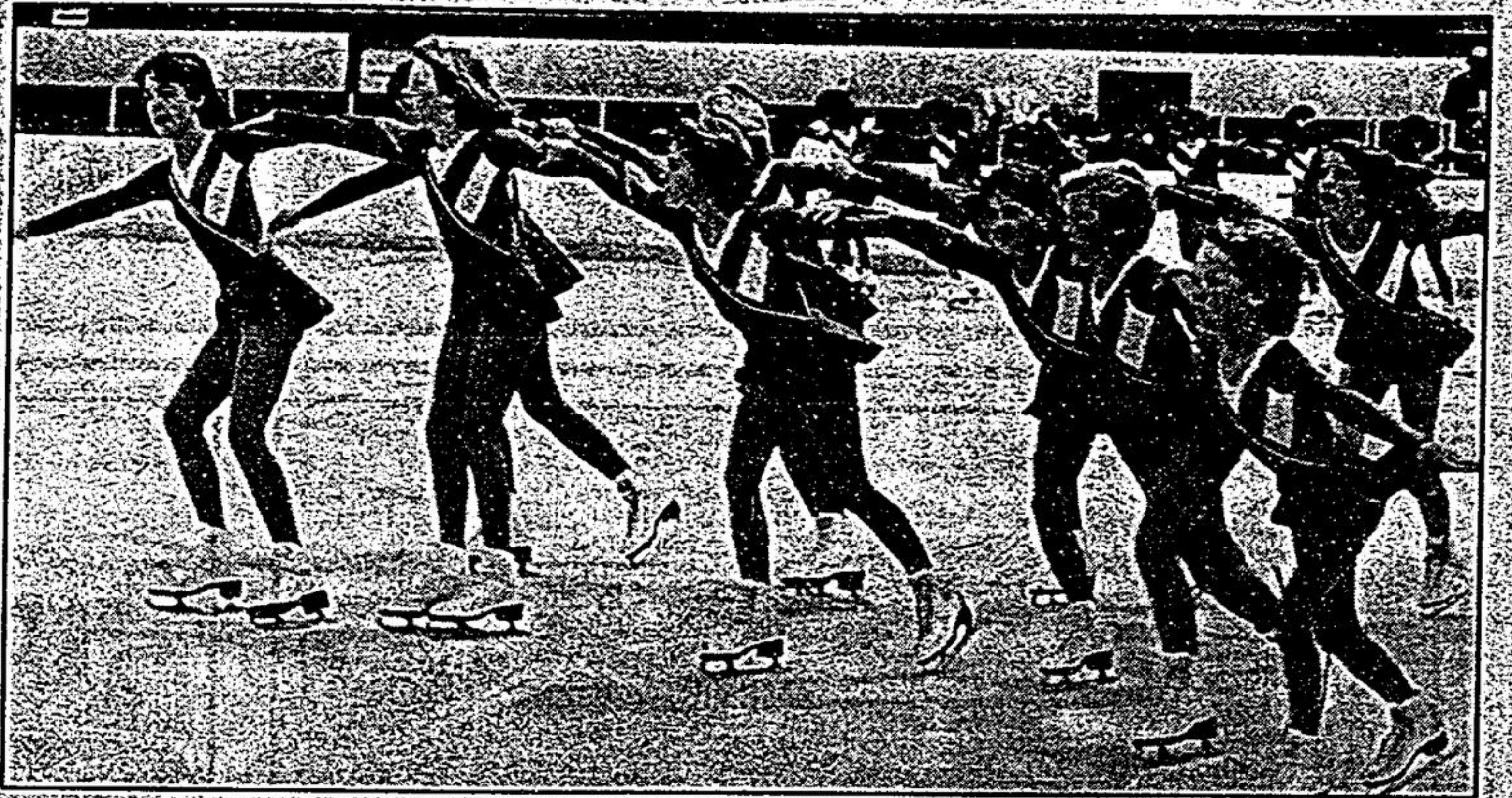
Football draw
