John Myers, a resident of Unionville, is a seven-year veteran of the York Region Board of Education.

Employed as a vice-principal in North York, Mr. Myers, 52, believes the challenge in the next three years will be to provide quality education in a time of fiscal restraint.

"I will continue to press for improvements in programs, espe-

cially at the primary level and in the modernization of equipment including computers, business and shop machinery," he said. "As a member of the budget review committee, I will do everything I can to make sure that our taxes are spent wisely."

Mr. Myers said a second challenge will be to gain approval for funds from the Ministry of Education to build new schools in York

Region.

"Our most pressing need is for construction of the next high school in the Milliken/Armada area," he said. "Unless we can open this by 1989 we will be facing unacceptable overcrowding at

Markham and Unionville high schools."

Mr. Myers is married and has a daughter in Grade 13 at Markham District High School.

Teacher trustees are Atkins big concern

Anne Atkins has lived in Unionville for 15 years and is a member of several community organizations, including the Markham Unionville University Women's Club and the Unionville Ratepayers' Association.

Mrs. Atkins, a former elementary school teacher, said one of her main concerns is the growing practice of school board employees serving as trustees. It has the potential to undermine the positive role school boards have traditionally played in Ontario.

"Such trustees must declare conflict of interest and refrain from participating in such major board activities as settling teacher's salaries, benefits and working conditions," she said.

Mrs. Atkins would also like to see further development of co-operative education programs and a better method of dealing with contract disputes.

Other concerns include improving school accommodation in York Region and encouraging the co-operation of all concerned to

ensure Bill 82 has as positive an impact as possible on the education of Ontario's exceptional students.

Mrs. Atkins is married and has two children, David and Julia, both students.
