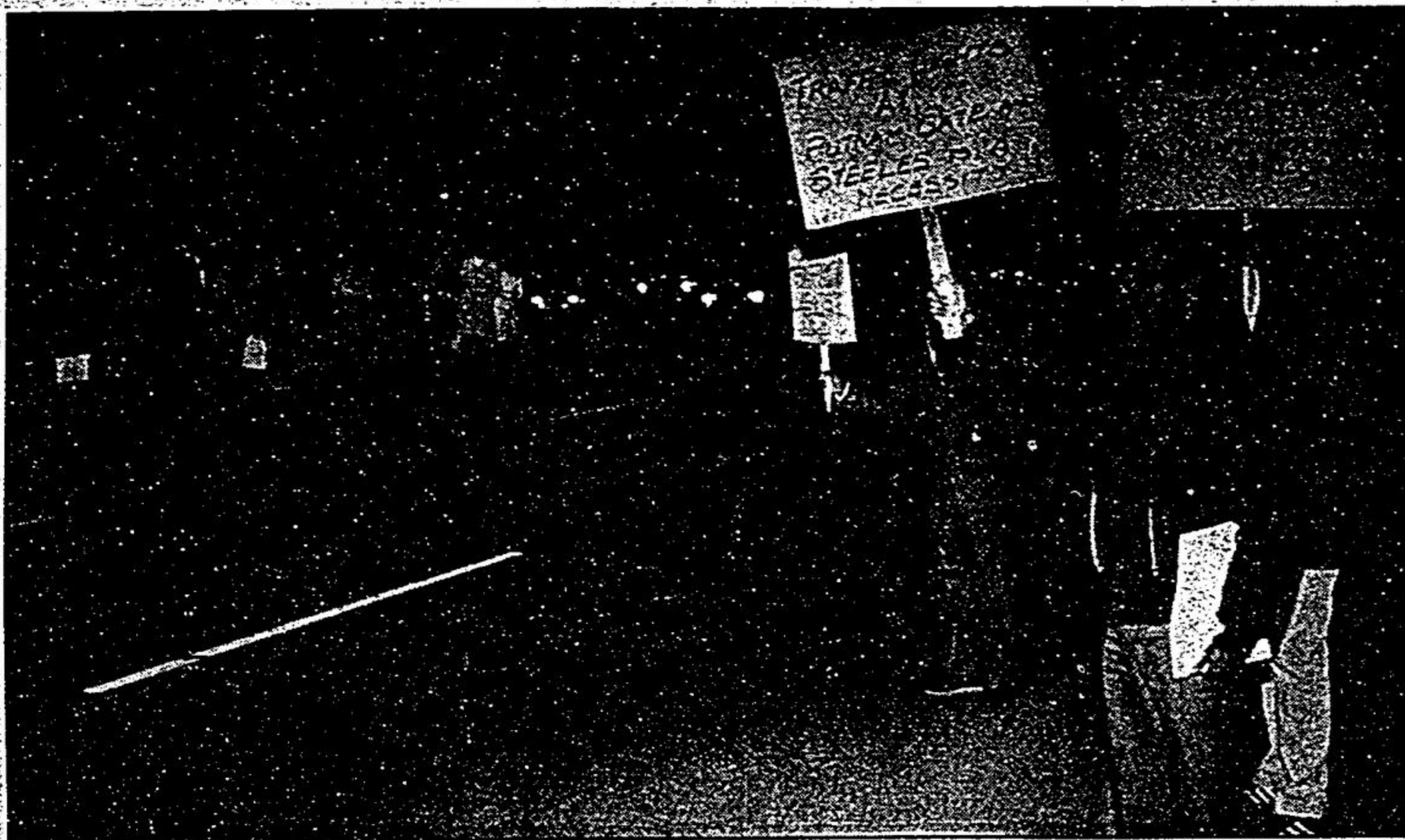


Christmas gifts galore at bazaar

Milliken residents lobbying for traffic lights at Steeles Ave. and Putnam Gate have edged a little closer toward their goal. The Department of Roads and Traffic of Metropolitan Toronto has given its recommendation for lights, but a final decision will be made by Metro Toronto Council in January. Murray Browning, director of traffic for Metro said, "The department will be recommending traffic lights go there, but I don't think it will get to Council till January. He said the municipal election

slowed down procedures, but that the recommendation would be presented to the transportation committee's first meeting of the New Year. Milroy Martyn, a Milliken resident, was part of a group which has been trying to convince traffic authorities in Toronto that lights are needed at the intersection. Pedestrians using Toronto transit must cross Steeles Ave. — a six-lane thoroughfare — to reach their neighborhood. During rush hour, which is when most transit riders are arriving home from work, these

people must dodge traffic for three lanes and wait on the island median until the three lanes in the opposite direction are clear. In October an elderly woman was killed at the intersection. Lobbying for the traffic lights has increased because of the death and several injuries which have occurred. Mr. Martyn said, "I don't think a young person can get across alone." The residents picketed the intersection recently during rush hour to make the public more aware of the danger at this intersection.
