"Brring, brring!" the telephone rang.

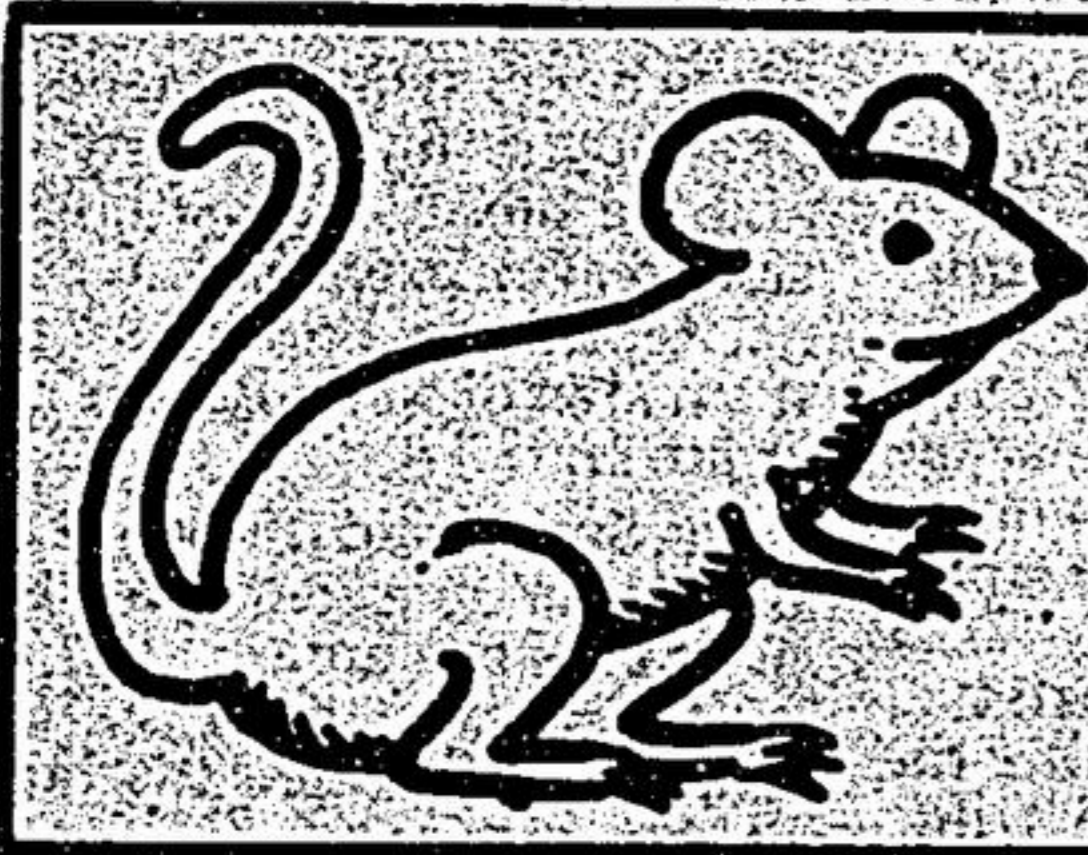

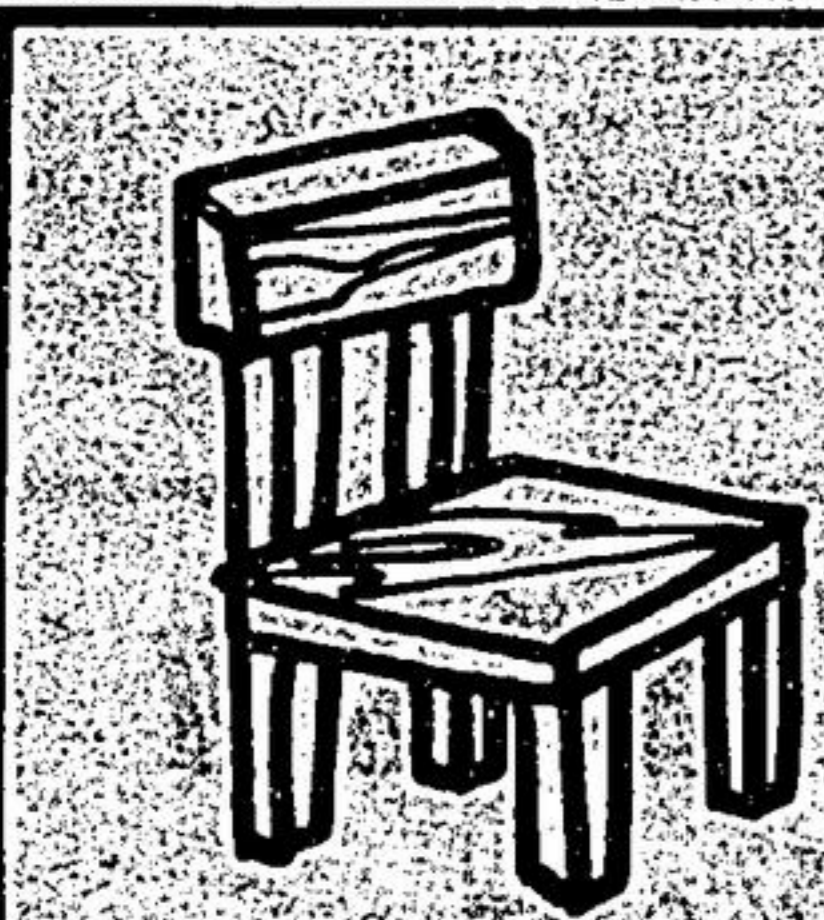
