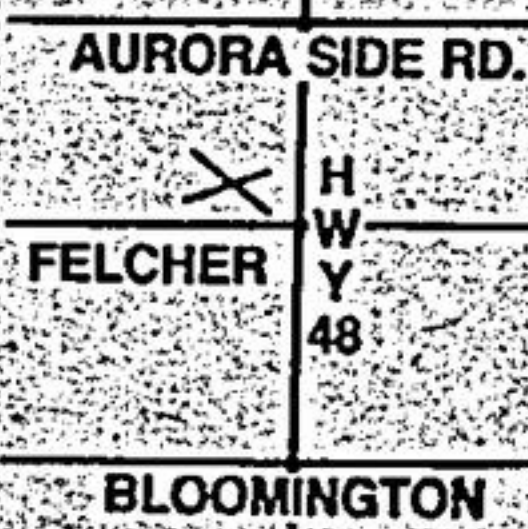

About 90 floats and eight bands will take part on Saturday, Nov. 30, beginning at 11 a.m. The theme is 'Santa's Workshop'.

The starting points are again Uxpool and Uxbridge Secondary School, with the route covering a large stretch of Brock Street. Parade participants will turn at Victoria Drive and continue past Uxbridge Cottage Hospital, providing patients a clear view.

Entries will be judged in several classes and awards presented afterwards. Santa will then hand out candy canes near Brock and Toronto streets and later at the hospital.

Organizer Bill Scott and parade committee members are making final arrangements for the event, which officially ushers in Uxbridge's Christmas season. It's financially supported by donations from the Township's business community.
