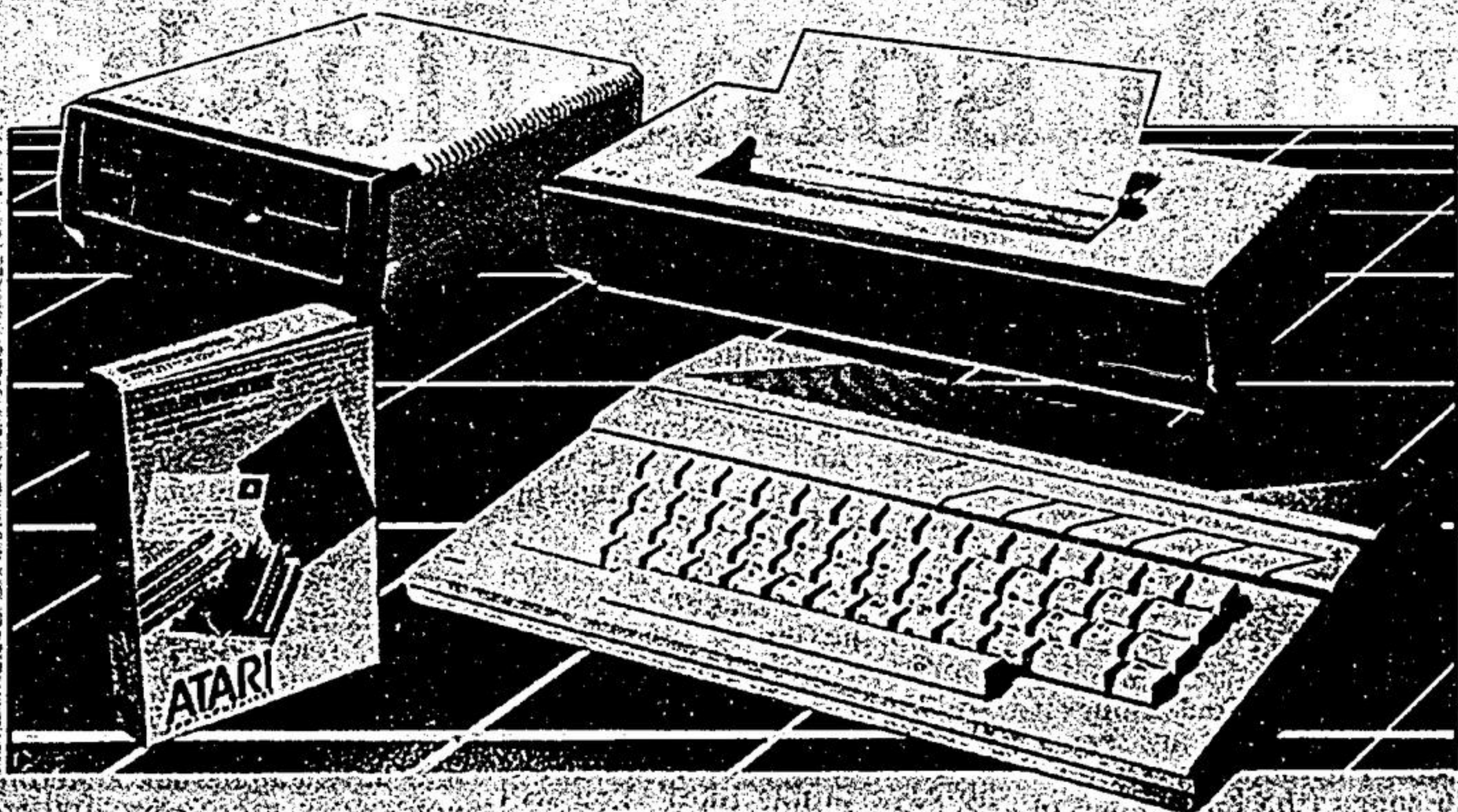

Film crews shot locally for small town atmosphere

Don't be surprised if some familiar scenery pops onto the screen the next time you watch television or visit a movie theatre.

Over the past several years Whitchurch-Stouffville, Uxbridge, Clarendon and surrounding communities have become popular with film crews seeking a small-town atmosphere.

Musselman's Lake had a recent brush with stardom as it hosted SCTV and Saturday Night Live alumnus Martin Short and company. On Labor Day, the multi-faceted performer taped part of his comedy special at the lake's old Sun Valley store. (The program was aired this month on a U.S. pay television service and will be shown on CBC television in February).

And portions of the CBC mini series Anne of Green Gables were shot this summer at sites in Whitchurch-Stouffville and at Pickering Museum Village. Dates for Channel 5's broadcast of the Lucy Maud Montgomery classic are Dec. 1 and 2, beginning at 8 p.m.

Charles Bronson's arrival at Uxbridge Cemetery Sept. 24 served to strengthen the area's reputation as Hollywood North. The screen tough guy walked through the burial ground during the making of his latest, An Act of Vengeance.

Mrs. Soffel, starring Diane Keaton and Mel Gibson, is another feature film displaying a

part of Uxbridge. The township's historic Quaker Meeting House was used in a scene taped in 1984.

The movie Martin's Day, parts of which were filmed in Stouffville back in October of 1983, is available on video cassette after a brief theatre release. The delightful story about a young boy's relationship with an escaped convict stars Richard Harris, Justin Henry, Lindsay Wagner and Karen Black.

Production crews from The Dead Zone (featuring Christopher Walken and Brooke Adams) and Nothing Personal (co-starring Donald Sutherland and Suzanne Somers), are among others to touch down in Stouffville.

The north Pickering hamlet of Clarendon is familiar to T.V. viewers for its frequent appearance in CBC's Seeing Things and in the oddball sci-fi film, Strange Invaders.

Clarendon and areas around Uxbridge are also featured in the \$1.3 million Canadian film, The Pink Chiquitas. The action comedy, which stars Frank Stallone and Claudia Udy, is scheduled for release next summer.

Meanwhile, Clarendon's hairstylist to the stars, Paul LeBlanc, has been on location in New Brunswick for the William Hurt film, Children of a Lesser God. Mr. LeBlanc won an Academy Award for his makeup work in last year's best picture, Amadeus.

Christmas concert

Clarendon's annual Christmas concert will take to the Community Centre stage on Sunday, Dec. 15, beginning at 2 p.m.

The event, sponsored by Clarendon Lions and Lioness clubs, features the singing, dancing and acting talents of many
