**Melba's Restaurant**

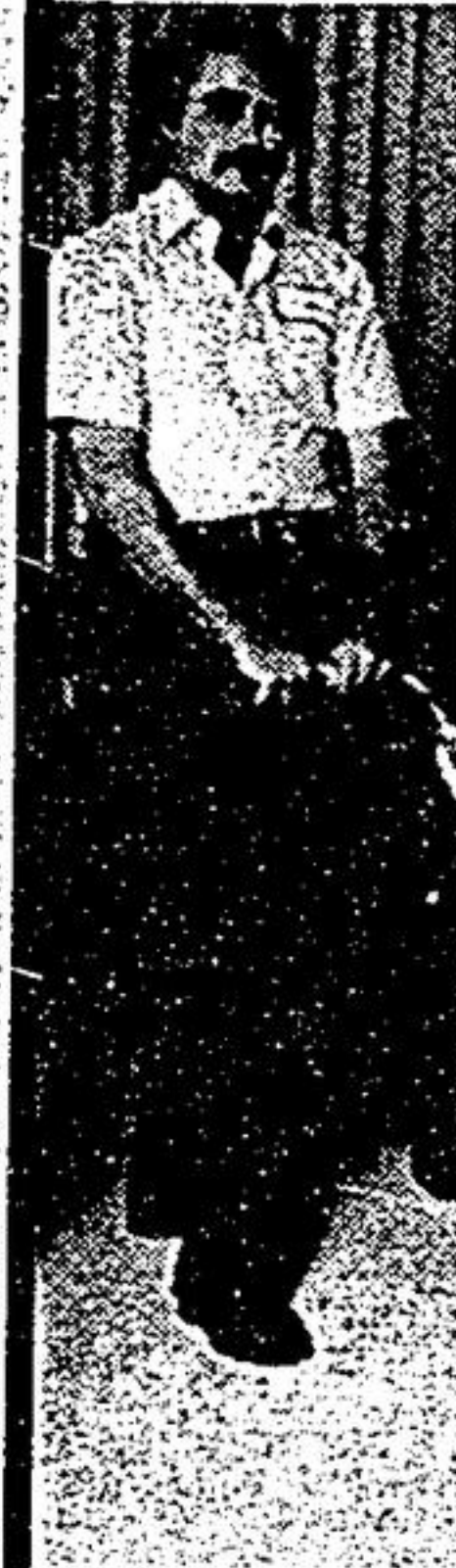
