It was because of his outgoing personality, he had so many friends.

His sudden passing, Nov. 20, at his residence on the 10th Concession, R.R. 1, Stouffville, came as a shock to many people.

It was while talking on the telephone with daughter Rita in West Hill, that he collapsed and died.

Rita immediately called her brother Bob who broke down the door and found his father.

Mr. Busato was 67.

Born at West Hill, Mr. Busato grew up in the market garden business. Following the sale of property at Malvern in 1957, he and his family moved to the east side of the 10th Concession. When this land was expropriated by the federal government, he purchased the John Mann farm across the road and built a new house at this location.
