Bruins finding the net

The Uxbridge Bruins clinched back-to-back games last week—defeating Port Hope 6-3 Thursday night and Lakefield 8-7 Friday evening.

Kevin Smith slammed two goals for Uxbridge, followed by singles from Tim Evans, Brad Burrows, Brian Stewart and Ken Burrows against Port Hope.

Shots on goal were just about even for both Junior "C" squads (32-31 for the Bruins). Joe Risk did net duty for both games.

John Miller scored the winning goal against Lakefield on a power play drive. However, if it weren't for Smith's hat trick, the Bruins could have written this one off.

Lakefield kept testing Uxbridge with go-ahead goals in the second and third periods. Still, Smith, Cliff Freckleton, Ken Burrows (on the power play) and Tim Evans (short handed marker) managed to close the gap on more than one occasion.

Bruin captain Todd LaRoche opened the shoot out in the first period. Teammate Paul MacEwen should be back in uniform for Friday night's encounter, with Bowmanville. He was riding a seven game suspension.

Bowmanville is tied for first spot with Cobourg. The Bruins occupy fourth position.

Hot goalies thwart Novice drive

Bad luck and hot goaltending thwarted the Neil Patrick Novice Clippers offence in three straight games last weekend.

The Clippers from Stouffville lost 1-0 to Port Hope Friday night, 3-2 to the Oshawa Canadians on Saturday, and 3-1 to Lindsay on Sunday.

Port Hope's game winner came mid way through the second period on a break away. Clipper goalie Greg Sandford was beat to the cor-

ner. However, Stouffville outshot and outplayed the Hope boys.

Geoff Smith gave the Clippers a 2-1 lead against Oshawa, late in the second period of Saturday's confrontation. It was shortlived. The Canadians came back to score two unanswered goals.

Lindsay set the tone of Sunday's wrangle by clobbering the Clipper mascot at centre ice during the pregame warm up. Still, Stouffville forwards Brad Goode and Brian Coughlan had some good chances to find the net early in the contest. They were frustrated by Lindsay's agile netminder.

Trailing 2-0 in the third period, Smith closed the gap on set up by teammate David Mountjoy. However, Lindsay came right back to make it 3-1. A goal by Clipper centre John McKinnon (son of Bob "Round the Net" McKinnon) was disallowed.

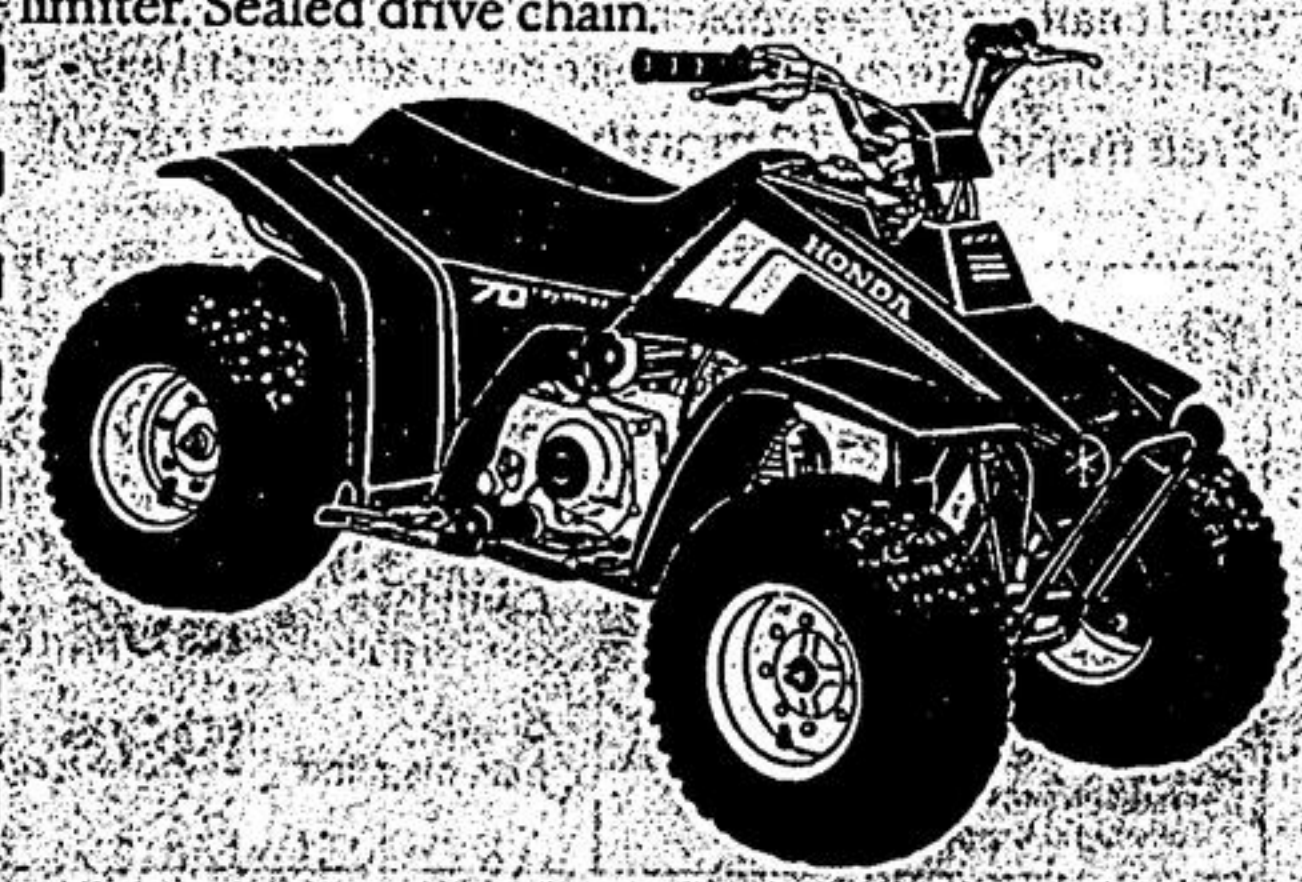
