With less than four minutes remaining in the third period, Uxbridge threatened to dissipate Smith's triple tally. The team scored two quick goals to shave the Clipper lead to 4-3.

Stouffville defenceman David Mountjoy made a dazzling play moments later to spoil an Uxbridge breakthrough and prevent a possible tie.

Clipper captain Phil Pridham put the finishing touch on a two-point win when he broke through the Uxbridge defence to find an empty net and slip home the insurance marker.

The Novice Clippers host Bowmanville on Friday night at 7 p.m. The local boys travel to Fenlon Falls for a tournament the following day.
