Local doctor on national team

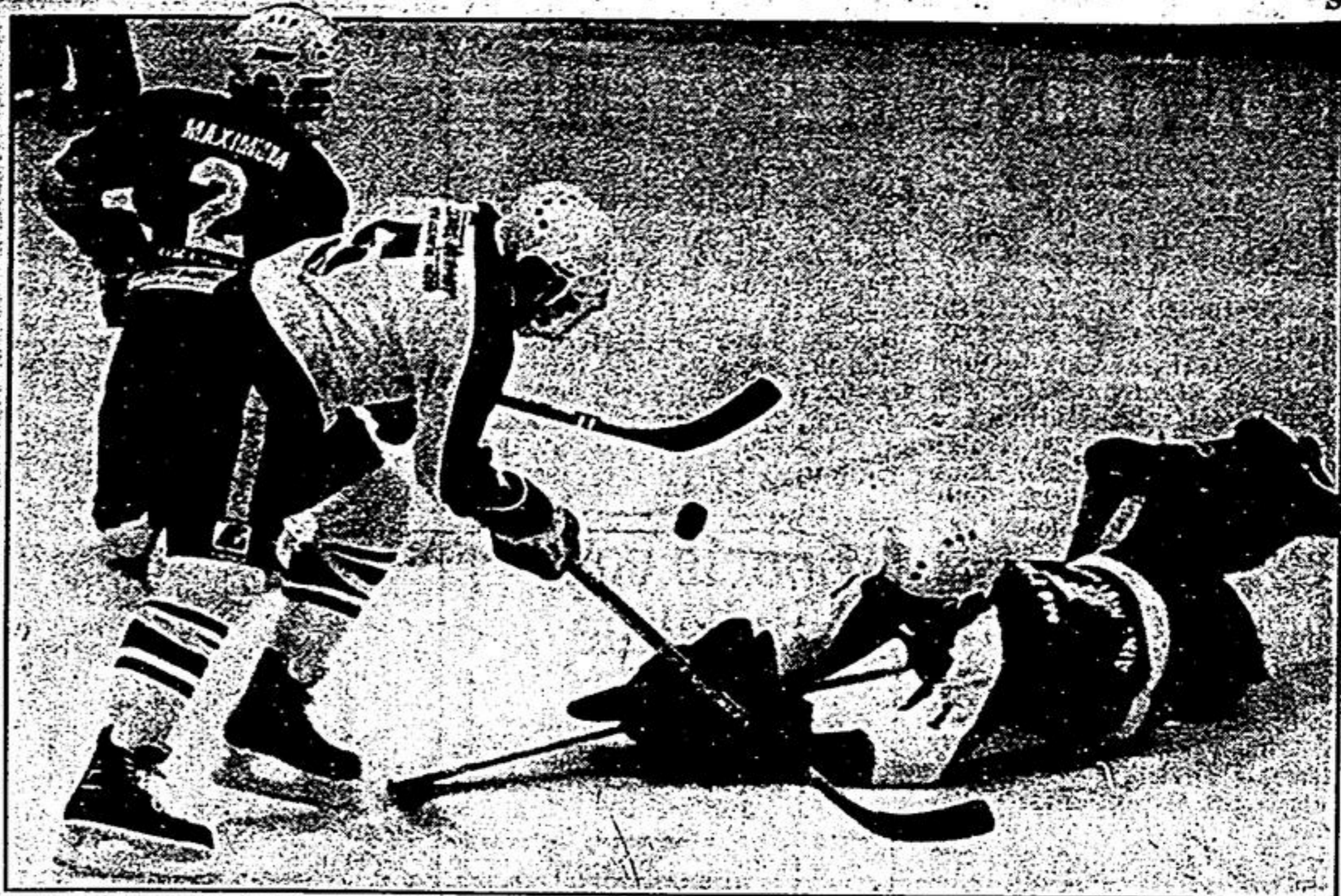
