

30 days in jail after fatal crash

A Markham man has been sentenced to 30 days for impaired driving relating to a head-on collision last September which took the life of a six-year-old boy.

Tyron Kerrutt, 46, will be permitted to serve his time on weekends. A charge of criminal negligence causing death for the same accident will be tried in Newmarket court Feb. 25.

The accident took place on Hwy 48 near Ringwood. Mr. Kerrutt was travelling northbound when he crossed the centre line and crashed head-on into a southbound vehicle. Neale Hagan, 6, died on the way to Scarborough Centenary Hospital. His father William was treated and released and driver John Jones, 55, was admitted to hospital in serious condition.
