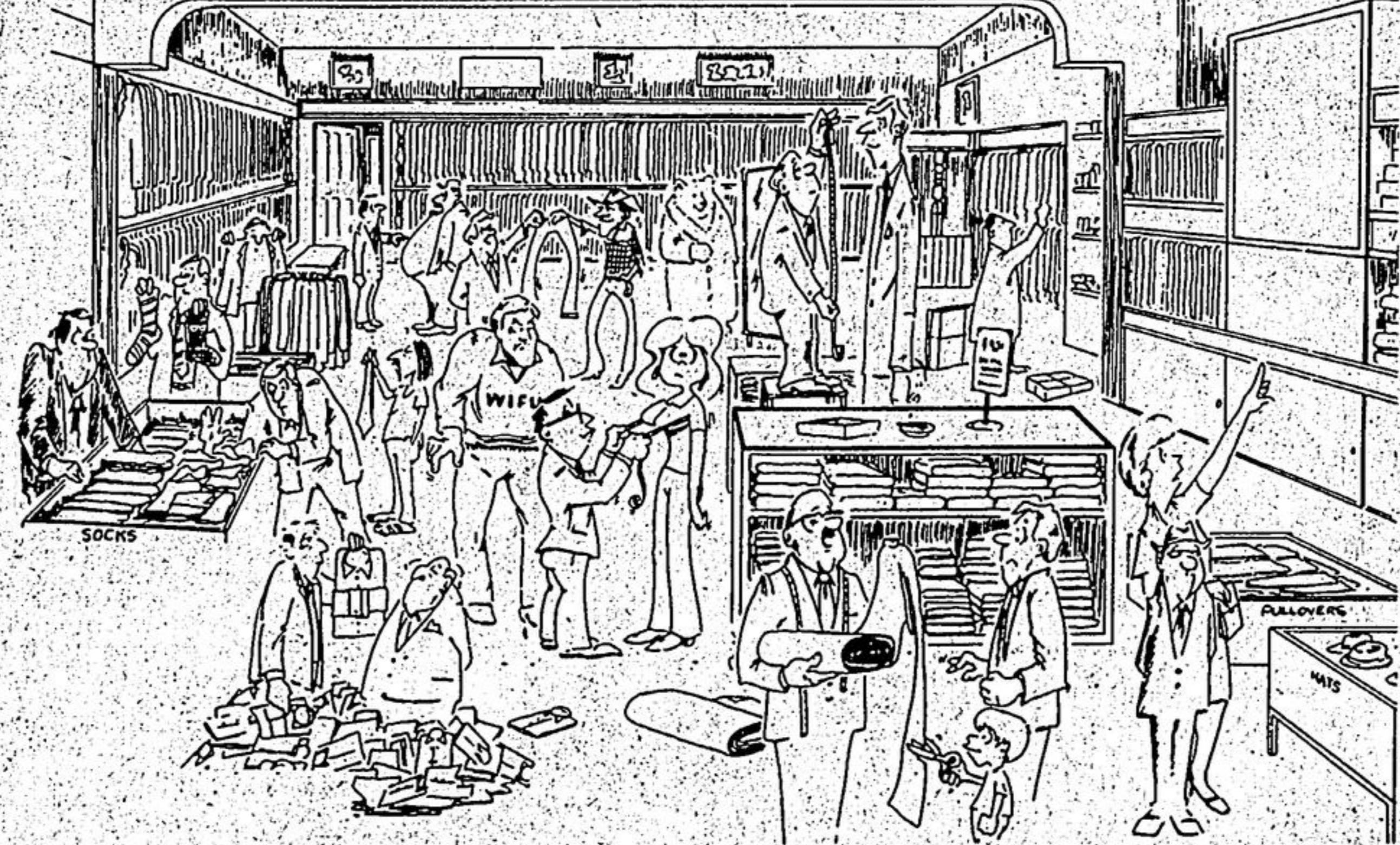
Bare facts recalled
