

## Players on stage

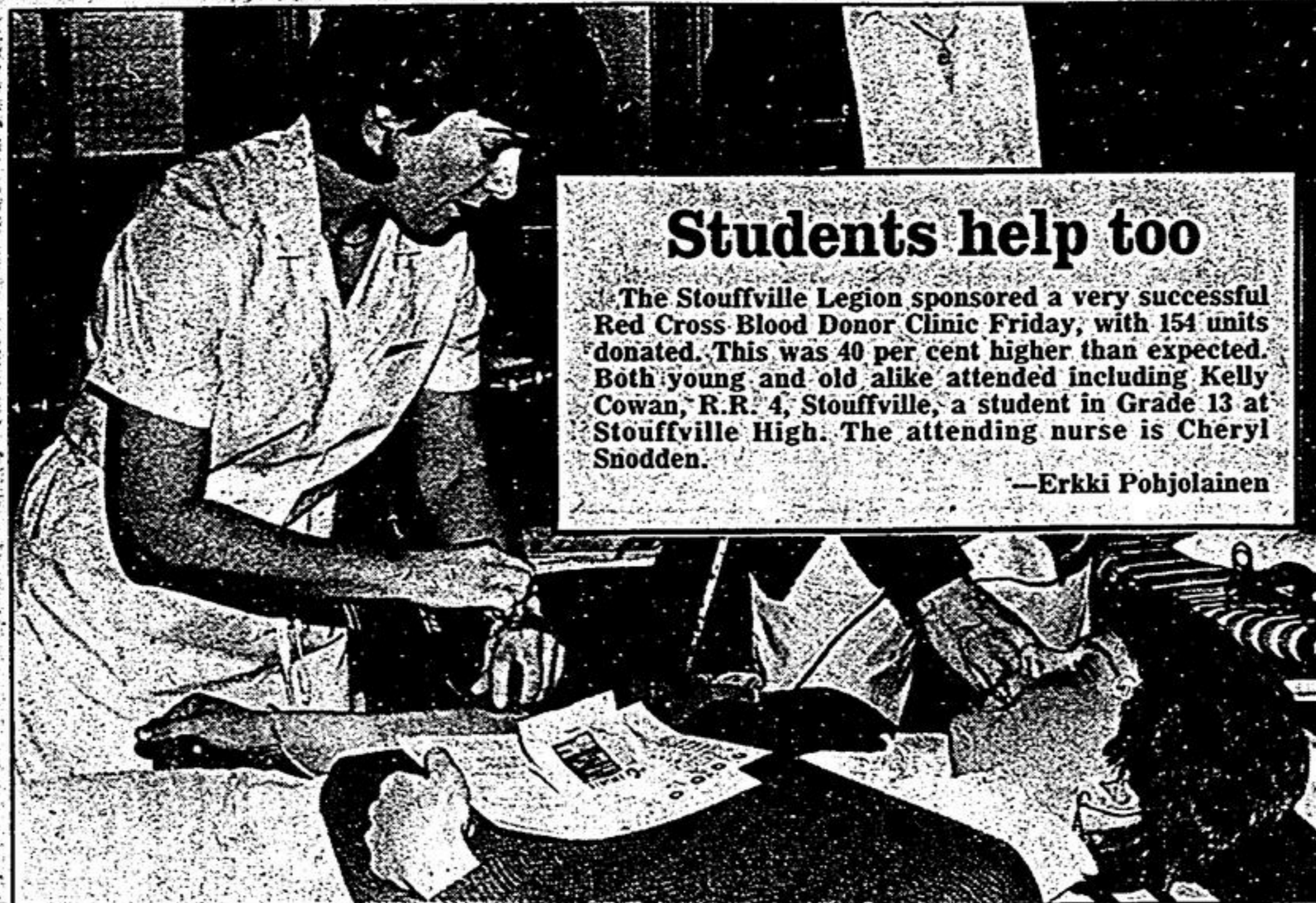

## Editor's Mail Higher rents

Dear Editor:

Recent correspondence in The Tribune regarding 105 Winlane Drive, raises some interesting issues.

The \$324.50 per month for a single bedroom apartment mentioned several times in your paper, only relates to very few long-term tenants. Most rents are considerably higher. New tenants are being charged as much as \$481.00 per month.

It should be noted that the tenants of 105 Winlane Drive do not set the rent levels. Rent ceilings were established in 1980 by the provincial government. All the tenants of 105 Winlane Drive want to do is pay the legal rent set by the Residential Tenancy Commission.

Very little has been done regarding our original complaints that were listed in your Oct. 30, 1985 edition. To our knowledge, a few work orders have been completed. However, little or no action has been taken on the replacement of hall and elevator

carpets, heating, plumbing, plastering, electrical problems and replacement of non-existent screen doors.

We do not mean to place the blame for this lack of action on the superintendent. He is only a part-time employee.

The Tenants' Committee of 105 Winlane Drive was formed in order to work WITH the landlord in resolving problems within the building. It is our attitude that we have tried to take the positive and productive approach. It was not, and is not our intention to enter into 'feuds'.

We merely want a properly maintained building and the legal rent. We will continue to work towards these goals.

We thank you for your paper's continued interest in this matter.

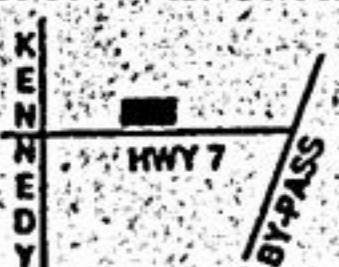
