## New stockbroker delighted to be open in Markham

For stock broker David Chalmers, the Town of Markham is the place to be.

Mr. Chalmers recently opened the 14th Canadian office of Davidson Partners Ltd., a full service brokerage firm that specializes in stocks, bonds, commodities trading and mutual fund investments.

"The response from both investors in the area and brokers has been excellent," Mr. Chalmers said from his Woodbine Ave. office last week. "It's interesting because word got around rather quickly."

Though the firm has been doing business for some time, it only celebrated its official opening yesterday.

Mr. Chalmers said he opened

a branch in the area because of its highly commercial and industrial growth rate. He said his is the first brokerage firm in that area.

"As many people know, this area is growing dramatically," he noted. "The potential for business here is tremendous."

With a current staff of 10, Mr. Chalmers said most investment objectives can be realized by clients. There are also plans to expand in the summer and add five more brokers to the staff.

"You would be surprised at the cross section of people who invest their money. We would advise the client on his investment, depending on the objectives he has," Mr. Chalmers said.

## Council to order transient vendors to move elsewhere

Markham Council plans to crack down on roadside vendors come spring.

In a motion passed Tuesday, council will request the Ministry of Transportation to pass legislation forcing transient vendors off provincial highways.

"It is a problem and the OPP will have to move (vendors) even though they may not find it that important," Mayor Carole Bell said in an interview.

Provincial legislation would also allow municipalities to pass bylaws prohibiting the roadside stands, and give local police forces (such as York Regional Police) jurisdiction on local roads.

Mayor Bell said the most troubled areas are Yonge St. and Hwy 7.

A report to Markham council said numerous complaints were received by Town staff from area businesses concerning the temporary booths that dot local roads selling everything from pies to flowers.

"We have had a lot of complaints from people who pay business taxes and realty taxes," Mayor Bell noted. "We're going to be very, very tough on (transient vendors) this year."

Mayor Bell pointed out that local farmers selling their own produce will be exempt from police intervention if they are selling from their farms.

"That's fine because they are our farmers," she said. "But it's the people bringing in their stuff from God knows where that we'll be moving along."
