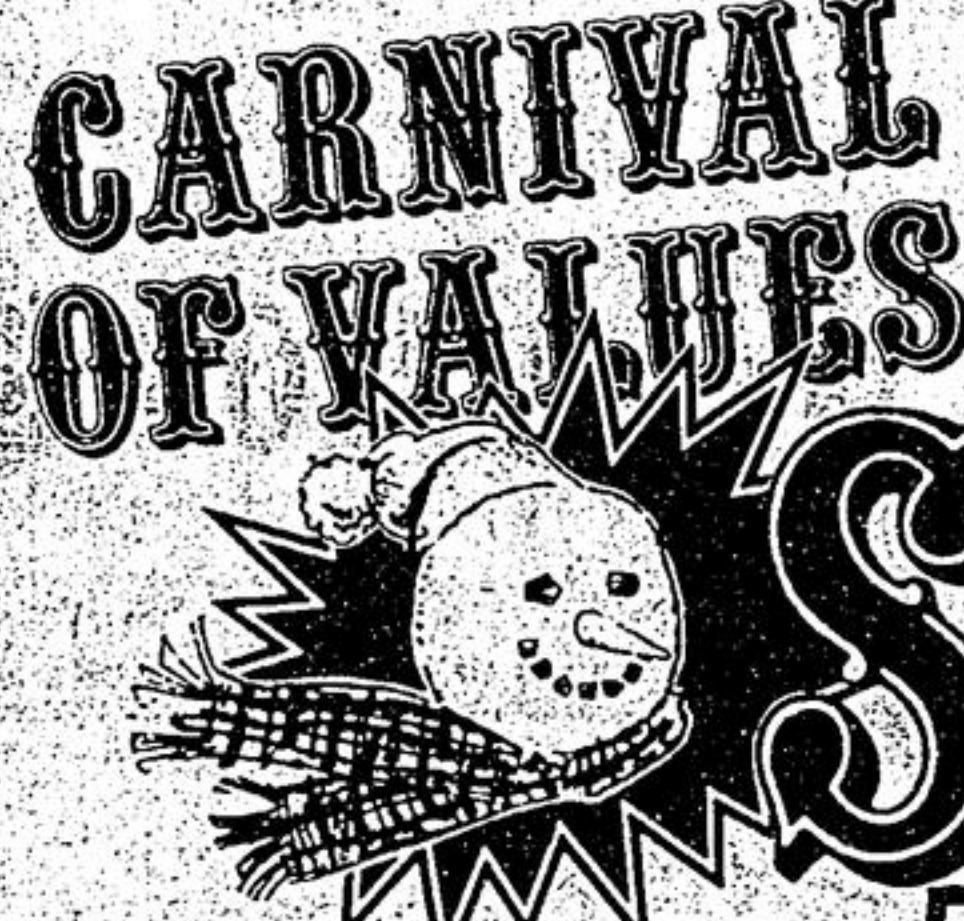
**Sells what people want**

**UXBRIDGE** — Since opening last October, Aqua Sleep and Linen Shoppe has enjoyed a sales volume "other (established) stores in the area would have been happy with," manager Dagmar Bastmeyer said.  
 The reason behind their success is simple, Case Bastmeyer, Dagmar's husband, said in an interview at the store. "I surveyed the area to ascertain what store would be feasible."  
 The result of that survey is the

only water bed specialty shop in the area surrounded by Stouffville, Uxbridge and Port Perry. "And business has been good," Mr. Bastmeyer said.  
 But the store sells more than just water beds. About a third of the inventory will soon be made up of conventional and air-mattress models. They also sell a variety of linens for which there is no competition in the area.  
 As Mrs. Bastmeyer said, "a linen shop can't be found any closer than Pickering."

Mr. Bastmeyer finds Uxbridge is a good location for a store. So good, he said, he intends to relocate his jewelry shop from Toronto to a part of the same building his wife's store is in, on Brock Street West.  
 "The thing that struck me," Mr. Bastmeyer said, "is that water beds are not just sold in the city. Farmers are buying them too."  
 The Bastmeyers have lived on a 10-acre hobby farm near Coppin's Corners for the past five years.
