Novice Clippers unbeaten

The Neil Patrick Novice Clippers blanked Uxbridge 5-0 last Sunday to extend their unbeaten streak in OMHA playoffs to 2 and 0.

The Clippers' defensive quartet of Brian Coughlan, David Mountjoy, Sian Morrison and anchorman Jason Reesor quelled a number of Uxbridge powerplay rushes in the third period which enabled goalie Greg Sanford to collect his second consecutive shutout.

Captain Phil Pridham put Stouffville on the scoresheet less than a minute into the game with a low shot that caught the right hand cor-

ner of Uxbridge's net. Lindsay Haylow set him up on the play.

However it was teammate Geoff Smith's three-goal splurge that effectively put the contest out of reach. He beat former Clipper Dwayne Vanderligt (who now wears the pads for Uxbridge) in the first and second periods.

Roger McMann rounded out the point-parade in the final period with an unassisted marker. The young Clippers travel to Port Perry on Friday for the return leg of their current round-robin playoff series, and conclude with back-to-back games against the Pickering Jets.

Peewees blitz Owen Sound

The Stouffville District Credit Union Peewee Clippers annihilated Owen Sound 9-0 Sunday afternoon to take a 1-0 lead in the second round of OMHA playoffs.

The Clippers' highlyfling forward Jason Underwood collected five goals and two assists in the massacre. Scott McKinley scored a pair of markers and capped one assist. Keith Piette and Greg Frederick captured a goal and assist respectively.

Underwood was involved in a dramatic incident last Saturday night during an exhibition contest against Oshawa. An opposing forward attempted to cross-check Underwood

who had picked up considerable speed on a rush from his end-zone. The Clipper literally flew past the stunned Oshawa checker who lost his stick (it snapped in half) and glove in the flurry.

Stouffville already embarrassed Port Hope in the opening playoff round — a best-of-five series that was chopped to three because of unequal club strengths.

Clipper coach Glenn Whitebread takes his team to Quebec this week for an international tournament. Whitebread's crew has won two atom and novice BB Lakeshore Divisional titles in the past six years. That record evidently convinced Quebec officials to invite the strong Stouffville squad.



Gymnast in top six

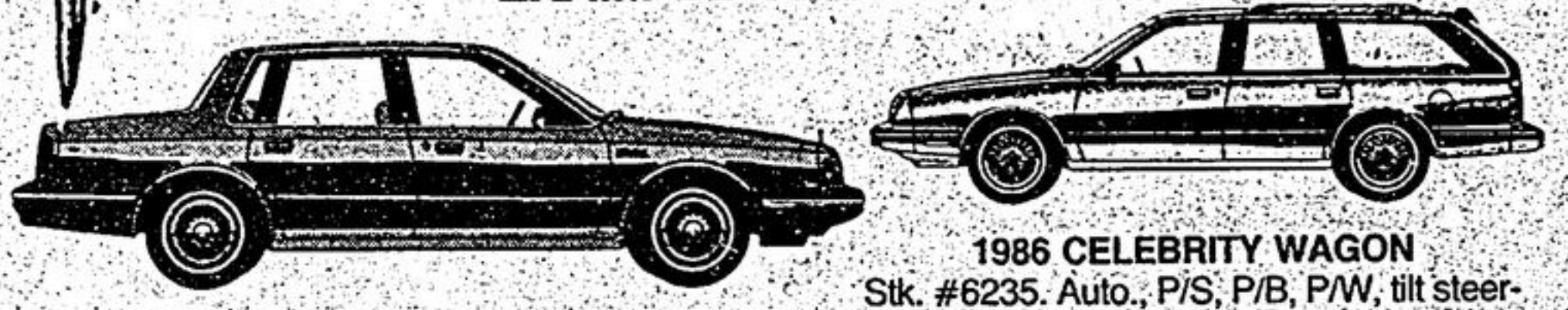
