Parkway looking to name new restaurant

The Parkway Hotel which will become the Sheraton Parkway Hotel in June, is holding a Name the Restaurant Contest.

The restaurant, which will be situated in the new atrium, will have four eating areas. A coffee shop, bakery, formal dining area, and garden court setting. The dining facility will overlook the hotel courtyard, Buttonville Airport and surrounding area. It will seat 142 persons.

The multi-level restaurant will offer a permanent buffet table for hot and cold foods, salads and desserts. Deep-toned wood paneling, historic artifacts, touches of brass, mirrors and rattan furniture will highlight the decor. Colors will be green and peach, grey and teal blue-green wall coverings and fabrics.

The 75 seat lounge is adjacent to the restaurant.

"We want the local community and our guests to feel that this is their hotel," said Sheraton Parkway owner John Kaptyn. "We welcome their involvement while the plans are still on the drawing board."

Participants in the contest are eligible to win a Weekend Extras vaganza for two in one of the hotel's deluxe suites complete with private jacuzzi whirlpool, plus champagne brunch, arrival gift and gourmet dinner. Winners will enjoy the indoor/outdoor pool, sauna, squash and tennis.

The winner will also receive a complimentary dinner for two each month for one year in the new restaurant.
