This house a showpiece

 This house is not a home, it's a showpiece.

The wooden two-storey residence being built near the north-east corner of Hwy. 47 and 48 is not going to have a resident. In an interview at the sales office, another building at the intersection, David McFarlane, of Upper Canada Post and Beam, said the house is a sample of the types of homes they build.

The model, to be finished next week, shows the company's workmanship on 15 different architectural designs. Mr. McFarlane was quick to add "we

do a lot of custom work too."

Since moving the business from downtown Toronto to Ringwood, in June 1984, business has "picked up considerably," he said.

The company began in 1979, but was limited to selling only a few houses per year. But after the move, business soared. Last year, they sold 30 prefabricated post and beam homes. One went as far as Whistler, British Columbia. This year, Mr. McFarlane predicts they will sell between 40 and 50 buildings.

Contracts already signed this year include a townhouse complex in Collingwood, a two-store

building in Aurora and a clubhouse at a Brampton golf course.

The homes take about a month to assemble by a four-man crew. The material is delivered in pre-cut, ready-fit, pieces that are simply put in place. For example, the roof is delivered in four-by-eight-foot sections which are complete with insulation and ceiling tiles. The crews simply fasten these sections to the raised post and beam structure.

The lumber is cut and fitted at the Ringwood shop and shipped to the site.

Though most of these houses are sold as year-round homes,

some have been built to serve as chalets and cottages.

Unemployed youths learn word processing

Ten unemployed youths will have the opportunity to learn word processing skills thanks to a course set up through the Canada Employment and Immigration office and the Markham Word Processing Centre.

Free of charge, the 13-week course started Feb. 17, and is designed for youths between the ages of 15 and 24 who have been out of school for at least three months.

In addition to computer skills, students will be taught typing, dictaphone, business english and life skills. A five-month job placement period follows the in-class training for successful students.

The course "is to help unemployed youth," according to instructor Rubi Talavera who says, though the course is open to people from any area, she would prefer the students be from Markham.

During the training, students will be paid minimum wage and—depending on their personal situation—some could qualify for further assistance.

Classes will be held at the Markham Word Processing Centre and the number of students is limited to 10 to ensure a close student/teacher environment.

A second session will begin when the first group goes on placement.

Anyone interested in the course should apply through the Canada Employment and Immigration office.
