



Artist donates draw prints

BROUHAM — Brougham-based wildlife artist Marc Barrie has donated two limited edition prints for a fund-raising draw sponsored by Thickson's Woods Heritage Foundation.

The recent framed releases 'Out For The Afternoon - Red Fox' and 'On The Tamarack - Red-Breasted Nuthatch' are up for grabs Saturday, March 22 at the Goodwood-raised painter's Gallery Brougham.

Tickets, at \$2 each or three for \$5, are available at Gallery Brougham (located on Hwy. 7 west of Brock Road) or from members of the Pickering Naturalists. For more information contact the Heritage Foundation at

Thickson's Woods, located in Whitby near the Corbett Creek Water Pollution Control Plant, is the last of a thick forest of white pine that used to blanket southern Ontario.

When the property was to be logged by its owner two years ago, a group of concerned citizens came forward and purchased a 16-acre parcel. The group then established a heritage foundation to manage the woodlot's plant and animal life.

It continues to be a favorite site for birdwatchers.

Mr. Barrie, 24, donated the prints to help members pay off a \$55,000 mortgage on Thickson's

Woods.

Other recent releases by the former Uxbridge Secondary School art student are featured in the spring issue of Art Impressions magazine. On the cover is his painting 'Royal Visit - Mute Swans'.

His work can also be seen in the next issue of Wildlife Art News, the largest U.S. publication dedicated to nature art.


