Longtime resident dies

A grand old lady died last week and a chapter in Scarborough-Markham history closed when Jean Rae Thomson, nee Ormerod, died last Friday at Green Gables Manor.

Mrs. Thomson's father was Robert Ormerod, a Malvern and Scarborough pioneer. She was married in 1921 to David Arnold Thomson, who was a fifth generation descendant of the Scarborough pioneers, David and Mary Thomson, through Archibald Thomson.

The Thomsons were very active in St. Andrew's Presbyterian Church, Scarborough. Mrs. Thomson was prominent in the Women's Missionary Society and in 1967 was made an Honorary Member of the Women's Missionary Society of the Presbyterian Church in Canada.

Mr. Thomson was honored by St. Andrew's Presbyterian Church in 1973 after having served 50 years as an Elder.

Mrs. Thomson had been taught the art of china painting by Minnie MacDonald, grandmother of Jack and Bill Baird and Betty McLean, and had passed this talent on to many friends who treasure the limoge china painted by her and others she taught.

Arnold and Jean Thomson were active socially and in the various organizations in Markham and Scarborough. They were successful farmers on Midland Ave. in Scarborough until 1958 when they moved to Windridge Ave. in Markham, where they lived until 1981 when they retired, in failing health, to Green Gables Manor.

The Reverend Wendell MacNeill of St. Andrew's, for whom Arnold had served many years as Elder, gave a very fitting eulogy

to Mrs. Thomson at her funeral service last Monday. The couple had no children, but left many friends and relatives.




Jean Rae Thomson and David Arnold Thomson are seen here talking with former Markham Museum Curator John Lunau at the opening of the museum in 1971.
