Easter Sunday, the church will take part in a community Easter Sunrise Service at Hillcrest Mall, Richmond Hill, beginning at 7 a.m.

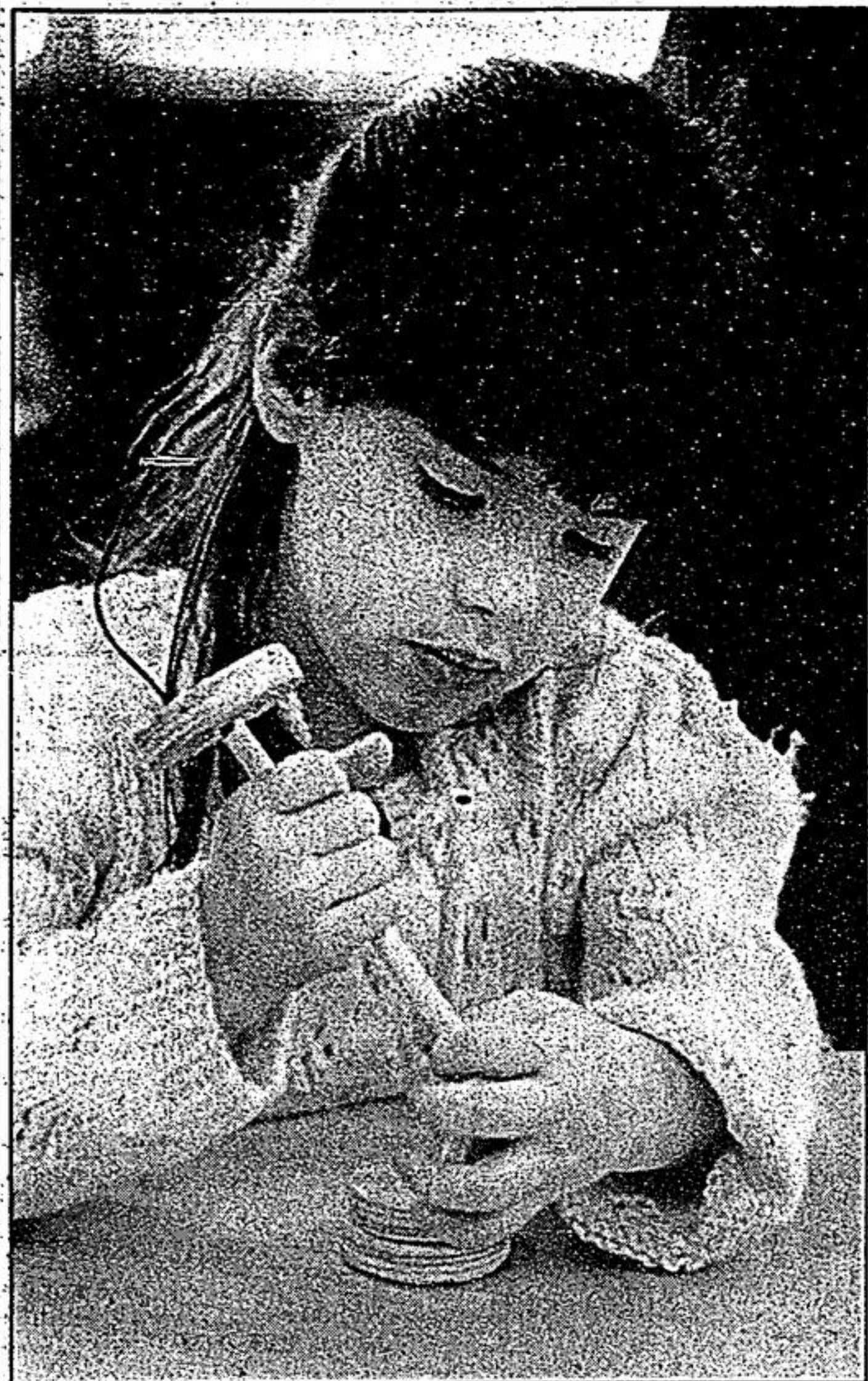
