## COMET WATCH

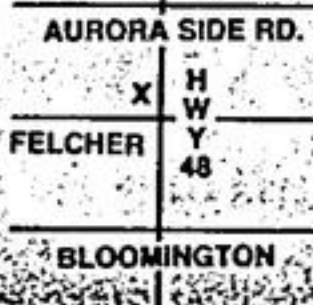
