Your editorial in The Tribune of March 26 under the heading Doctors' Token Protest, cannot go unchallenged.

You admit you are "not one to frequent a doctor's office more than necessary", so I assume you enjoy good health. You advocate a "9-to-5 day" with "on-call emergencies", which is exactly what doctors did last week.

While you advocate support for a rigid pay schedule for ALL doctors, would you support similar legislation for ALL lawyers, teachers, nurses, dentists, engineers, clergymen, politicians and even newspaper editors?

The doctors' "token protest" is the mildest form of dissent they can make to express their displeasure of an insidious Bill that, not only infringes on their rights as professionals and individuals, but also on yours.

They are not "attempting to tear down the finest health care system in the world", but to preserve it.

The Ontario Medical Association is prepared to work with the Government to perpetuate and embrace good health care and services, but is not willing to be railroaded into accepting a questionable Bill 94 by a precarious Government that relies on keeping its allies satisfied to hold onto power.

Doctors are here to stay and will be available when they're needed. Some Governments have questionable motives and tenure. If we have "the finest health care system in the world", let's keep it that way.

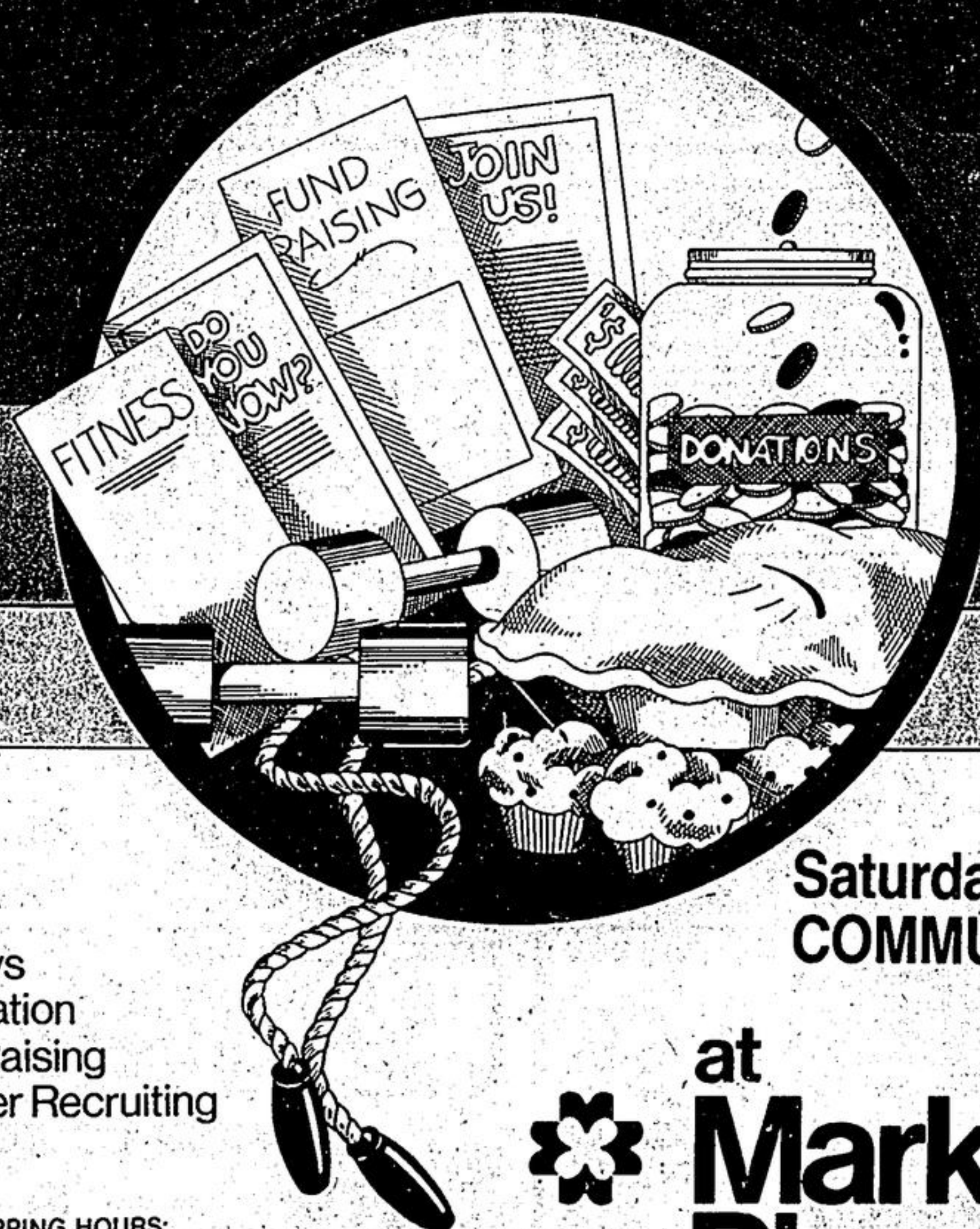
