Want an exotic sportscar?

Ever dreamed of owning a

Porsche, Jaguar or Ferrari?

Ever thought about how much

performance cars like that cost?

Well, thanks to a new Unionville

store, it's easy to own these exotic

automobiles, albeit in miniature

form.

You can buy a Porsche for \$17,

a Jaguar for \$30, or how about a

Ferrari for \$80. Want an Aston

Martin, that too is for sale at Mini

Grid, which held its grand opening

celebration last weekend.

Mini Grid offers ready-made or

do-it-yourself models and die-cast

replicas of sports and racing cars.

There are also racing posters, car

books and magazines for enthu-

sists of the sport.

Store manager George Max-

well has been in the business for 10

years. "I've always been inter-

ested in automotive miniatures,"

he said. "Cars are a part of

history."

He says the models range in

price from \$10 for plastic replicas,

to \$800 for specially ordered hand-

crafted models.

Mr. Maxwell moved his store to Unionville from Agincourt last November. He says Mini Grid is one of a select few stores of this type in North America.

"It's very specialized," he said. "We depend on word-of-mouth for customers."

Mini Grid also relies on its customers abroad and in the U.S. according to Mr. Maxwell, who said.

estimates the American market accounts for 60 per cent of his sales.

He says his customers include average racing fans, major auto companies, and former racing greats such as Stirling Moss, Brian Redman and before his death, Gilles Villeneuve. Present-day Grand Prix driver Patrick Tambay is also a customer, he said.

Other smaller stores like Mini Grid also make up a large portion of his business, he added.

"We're sort of the Godfather of it all."

Mini Grid is located on Hwy 7, just west of Kennedy Rd.

New business computer introduced

MAI Canada, Ltd. recently introduced a new MPx 7000 Series of 32-bit business minicomputers.

The 7000 series includes the MPx 7010, a single-processor system, entry-level minicomputer which can be configured with up to 20 terminals.

A dual-processor 7020 can be configured with up to 52 terminals. The 7020 system architecture allows parallel processing.

Both systems are equipped with 2 MB of main memory, a micro-

peripheral controller and a 128 MB 5 1/4-inch Winchester disk drive backed up by a 1/4-inch cartridge streaming tape unit.

Up to four, 5 1/4-inch Winchester disks and two parallel printers can be supported by the micro-peripheral controller.

Either system may be expanded with additional memory and additional 5 1/4-inch Winchester drives mounted in the system chassis.

Both the 7010 and 7020 support the full range of MAI Basic Four applications software.


The 7000 series has such features as virtual memory, data communications capabilities, a dual level security system, extensive utilities with help screens for user functions, and the ORIGIN


