STOUFFVILLE — Tribune carrier Paul Spencer has an eye to the future.

Although only thirteen and a student in Grade 7 at Summitview School, this polite, quiet-spoken Manitoba Street boy is already saving up for higher education. He plans to attend university after graduation from Stouffville High.

Paul has his own bank account and every dollar he can put aside is saved with this purpose in mind. While Science is his favorite subject, he's still not sure what course he'll follow. There's lots of time for that, he admits.

Paul began delivering Tribunes three years ago, making him one of the "veterans" with the newspaper's carrier team. He took over from sister Karen.

Paul's route includes Hawthorne Avenue and Baker Avenue. He has 28 subscribers, 24 of which a pre-paid, reducing monthly collections to a minimum.

Paul's a familiar figure to many people. He completes his rounds every Wednesday afternoon using a two-wheeled cart. If the weather's particularly bad, his father takes him by car. Tom and Elaine Spencer are enthusiastic supporters of son Paul and his carrier responsibilities.

Paul says he makes every effort to secure each newspaper, either between the doors or under the mats. He seldom receives complaints.

During the summer, when the family leaves on a camping holiday, Paul calls on the services of either Erik Jensen or Mike McCool to help him out.

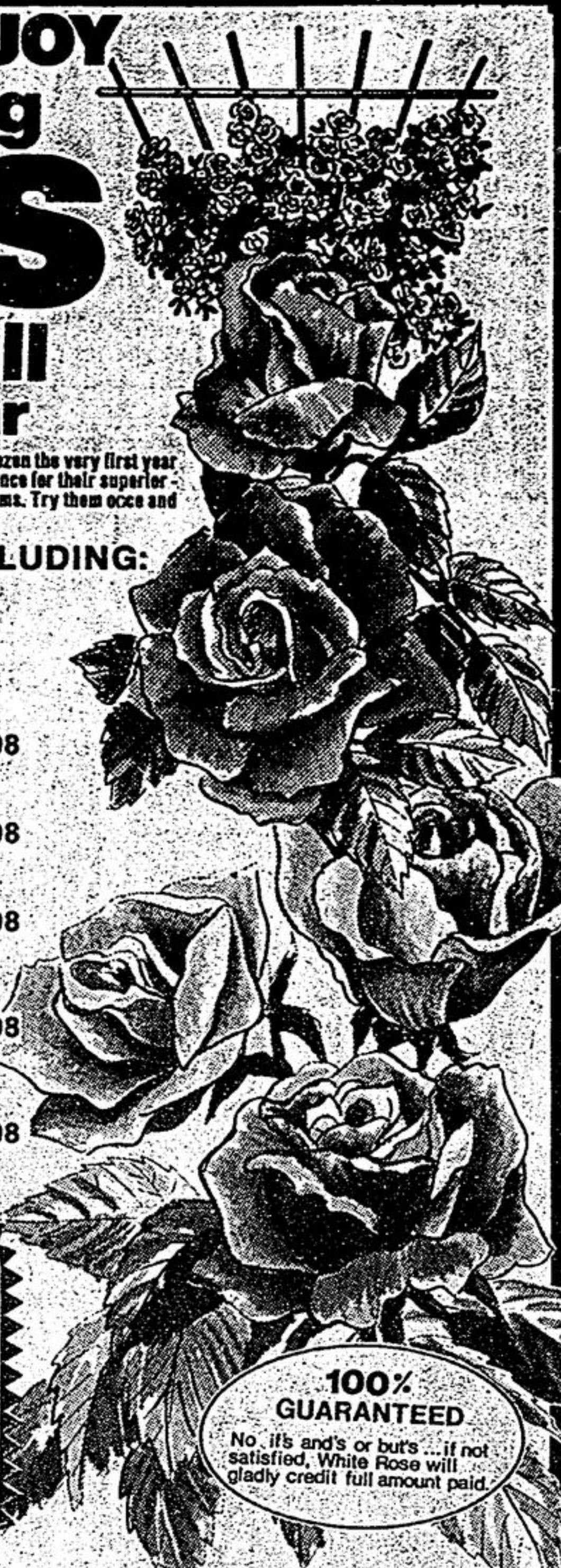
