

Well grants approved

CLAREMONT — The provincial government has granted over \$1.5 million to subsidize well improvements in the north Pickering hamlet of Claremont.

Durham York M.P.P. Ross Stevenson announced that a total of \$1,546,000 has been allocated by the Ministry of the Environment, with \$200,000 provided for the full cost of an engineering report on the project.

"I am very pleased to see the grant included in this year's budget after working hard to ensure the proposal's acceptance,"

Mr. Stevenson said in a press release.

The environment ministry will work to correct Claremont's widespread water contamination problem in conjunction with the Town of Pickering, according to Mr. Stevenson. All upgrading work is scheduled for completion within two years.

Funding applications are now available by contacting the Town of Pickering's municipal office at 683-2760.

Meanwhile, Council recently acted on behalf of a Claremont

couple who replaced a tainted well prior to implementation of the Hamlet of Claremont Private Water Systems Study.

In a resolution moved by Ward 3 regional councillor Norah Stoner and seconded by local representative Wayne Arthurs, the Town "requests the Honorable James Bradley, Minister of the Environment, to approve the request of Dean and Carolyn Evans for compensation," under that study.

The Evans, 5011 Barclay Street, installed a new system in 1984 after their water was judged unsafe to drink.

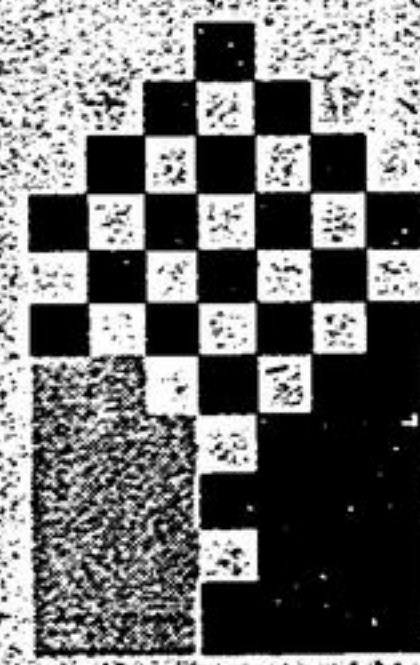
