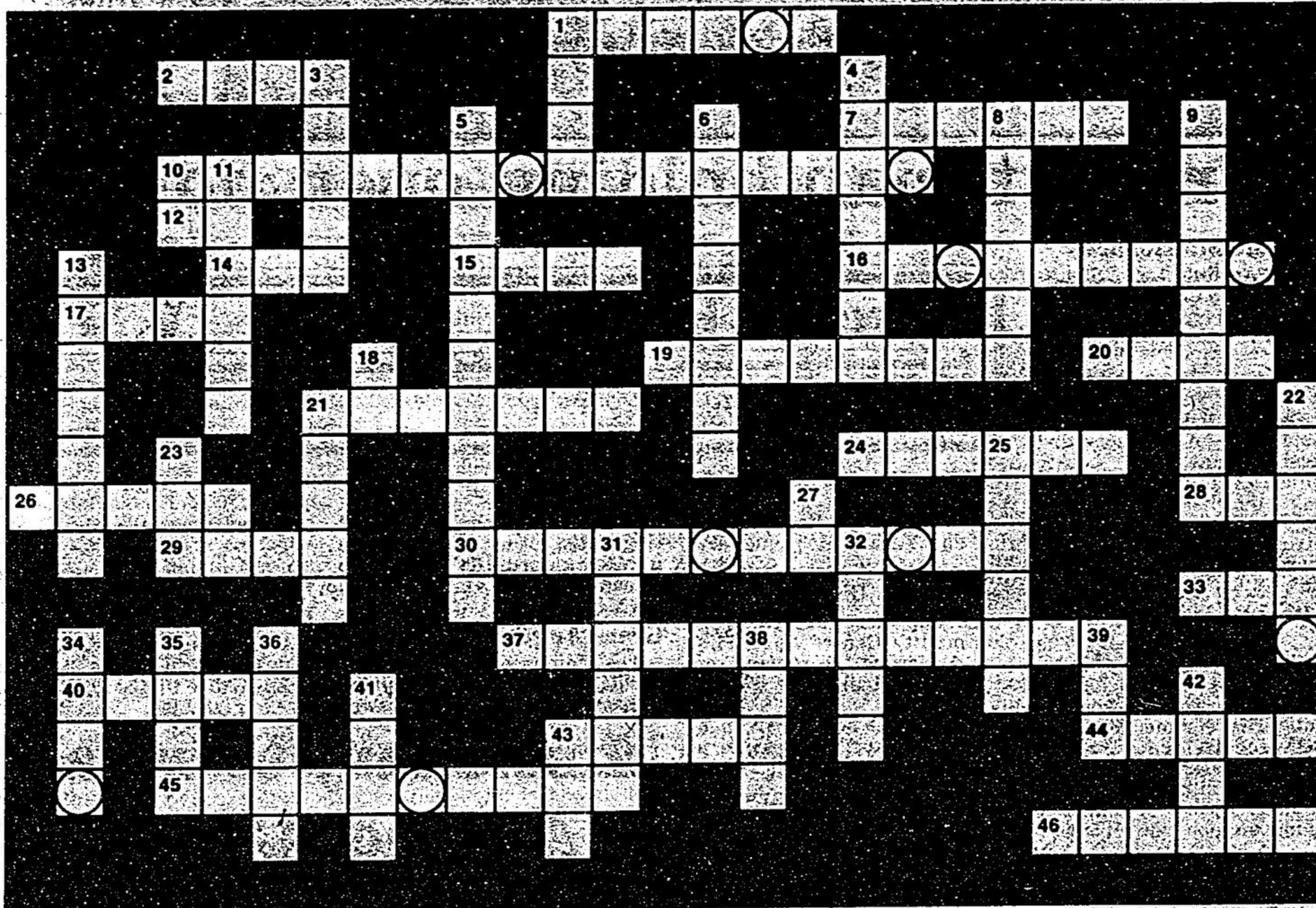

# Dental Poster Contest

The York Region Dental Society and the Weekender have teamed up to sponsor a poster contest to mark Dental Health Week from April 13 to 19.

Two pairs of Blue Jays tickets will go to three local winners of the poster contest.

Support Your Teeth is the theme of the contest which is open to three separate age categories: Kindergarten to Grade 1, Grade 2 to 4 and Grade 5 to 7.

The maximum allowed size of the posters is 36 by 24 inches. Posters containing trade names or the names of products will be disqualified.

Contestants should hand-in posters to their local dentists by April 19.

The three winning posters will be submitted to a provincial contest and winners from that competition will continue on to a national contest.

# Proper care of teeth

Informing the public about new dental techniques and the importance of proper oral hygiene is the purpose of Dental Health Week in Ontario, April 13 to 19.

"It's to make the public aware of what's happening in dentistry," says Dr. Perry Lichtblau, organizer of the event for York Region. "We're trying to educate."

To accomplish his goal Mr. Lichtblau, a dental surgeon in Markham, says he is changing the approach taken during previous Dental Health Weeks.

"In the past we've had mall displays (but) they haven't been very successful," he said. "The public wasn't educated in any way."

This time, he says, oral hygiene will be promoted through the local media with a crossword puzzle contest requiring some knowledge of dental health appearing in community newspapers throughout the region.

Prizes of a night at the Parkway Sheraton Hotel or the ChimoHotel will be offered to winners. Four tickets to a performance by the Toronto Chamber Works at the Markham Theatre will also be awarded.

Mr. Lichtblau will appear on Classicom cable television throughout the week to discuss dental techniques such as the replacing of teeth and bonding. He will also talk about new services available to the public.

Part of the project is the Dental Awareness Program which has been sent to local dental associations and Public Health Units. The program is comprised of a kit which contains an information poster, public service announcements and statistics.
