## Spring show a 'Classic'

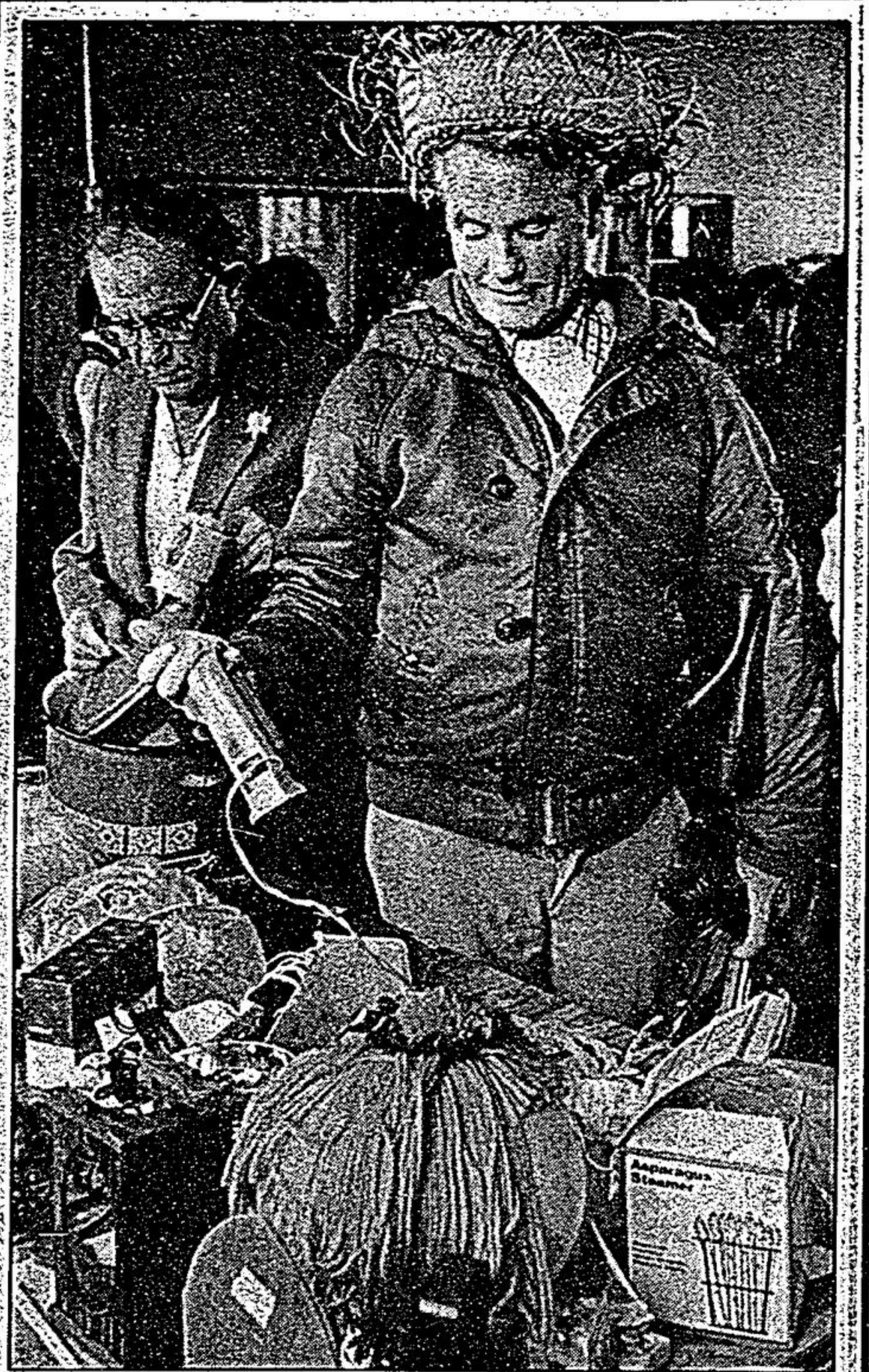
The latest in spring and summer fashions will be featured later this month at a fashion show and dinner sponsored by Classic Collection.

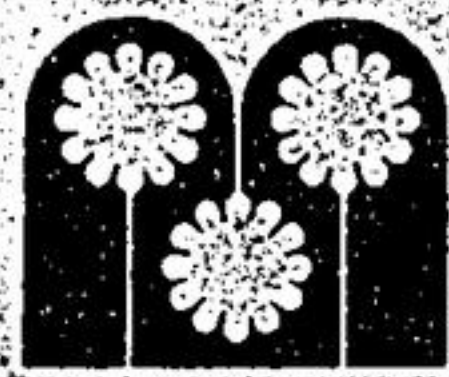


## Rummaging around
