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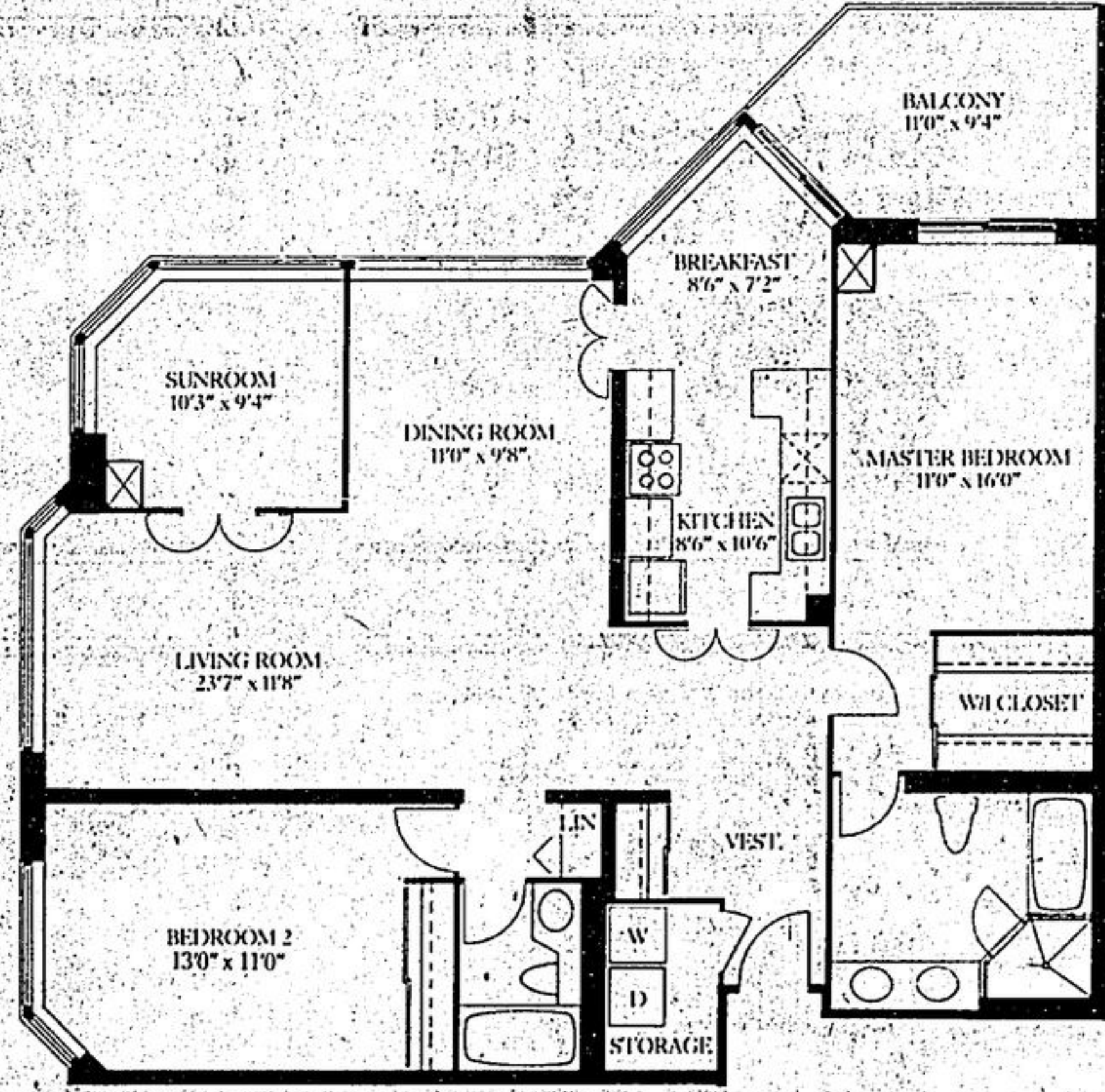

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NOTICE TO ALL RESIDENTS OF THE TOWN OF MARKHAM, AND THE TOWN OF RICHMOND HILL

NOTICE OF THE PASSING OF A ZONING BY-LAW BY THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF MARKHAM

TAKE NOTICE that the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Markham passed By-law 137-86 on the 22nd day of April, 1986 under Section 34 of the Planning Act, 1983.

AND TAKE NOTICE that any person or agency may appeal to the Ontario Municipal Board in respect of the by-law by filing with the Clerk of the Corporation of the Town of Markham not later than the 27th day of May, 1986 a notice of appeal setting out the objection to the by-law and the reasons in support of the objection.

An explanation of the purpose and effect of the by-law, describing the lands to which the by-law applies is outlined below. A key map showing the location of the lands to which the by-law applies are attached. The complete by-law is available for inspection in my office during regular hours, Monday to Friday, 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.

EXPLANATORY NOTE:
BY-LAW NO. 137-86
Amending By-law 165-80, as amended

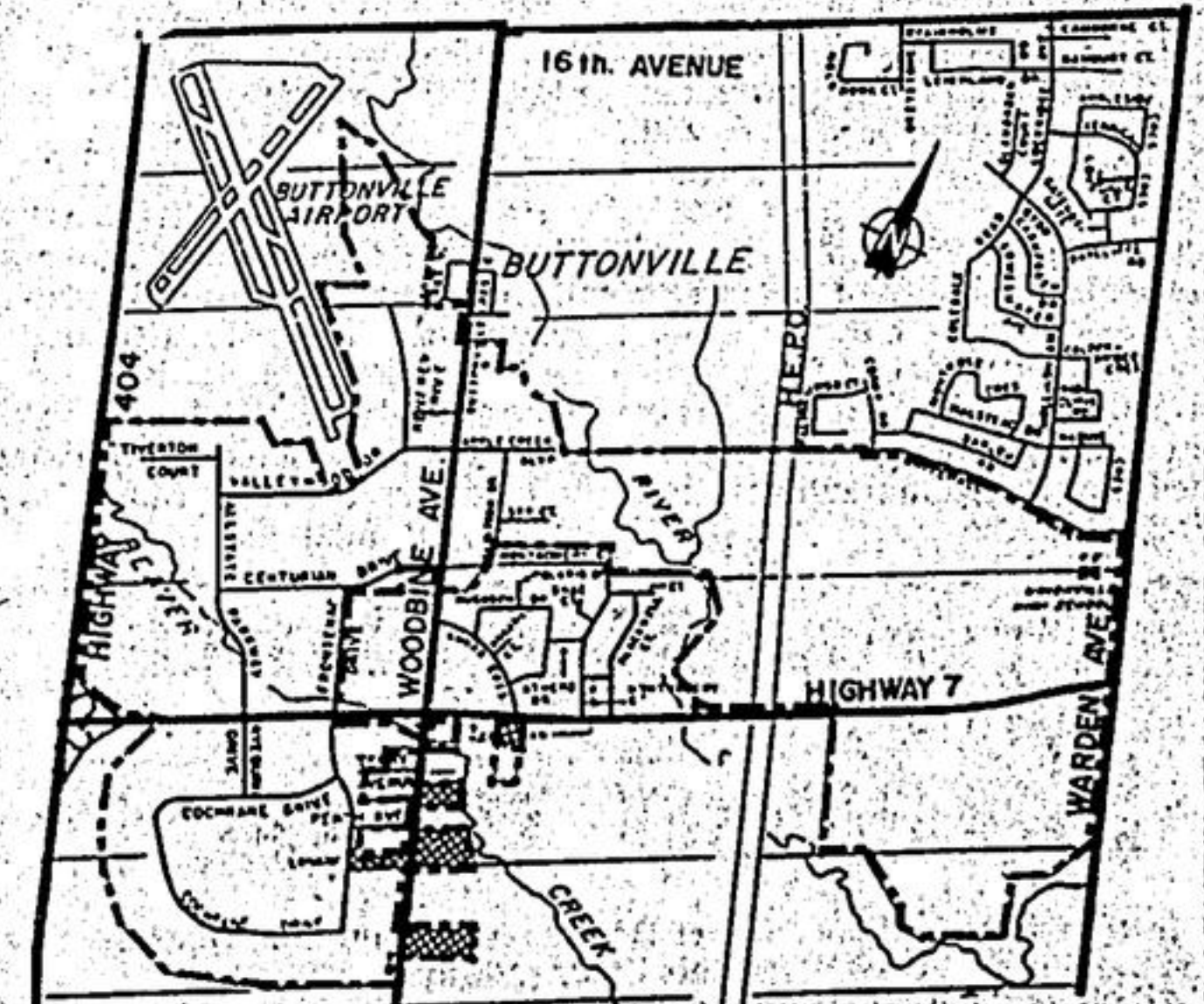
The proposed by-law amendment applies to the Special Commercial (SC1) zone category of By-law 165-80, as amended, being the Brown's Corners Zoning By-law. Special Commercial areas are intended for commercial uses or associated commercial uses which by their function generally locate outside of shopping centres.

The current list of permitted uses is very limited in scope and is not considered broad enough to adequately serve the area.

The purpose of the by-law amendment would be to expand the list of permitted uses under the SC1 zone category to include additional special commercial uses. The effect of the by-law amendment would be to expand the list of permitted uses to better serve the area.

All other provisions of the SC1 zone category will continue to apply.
