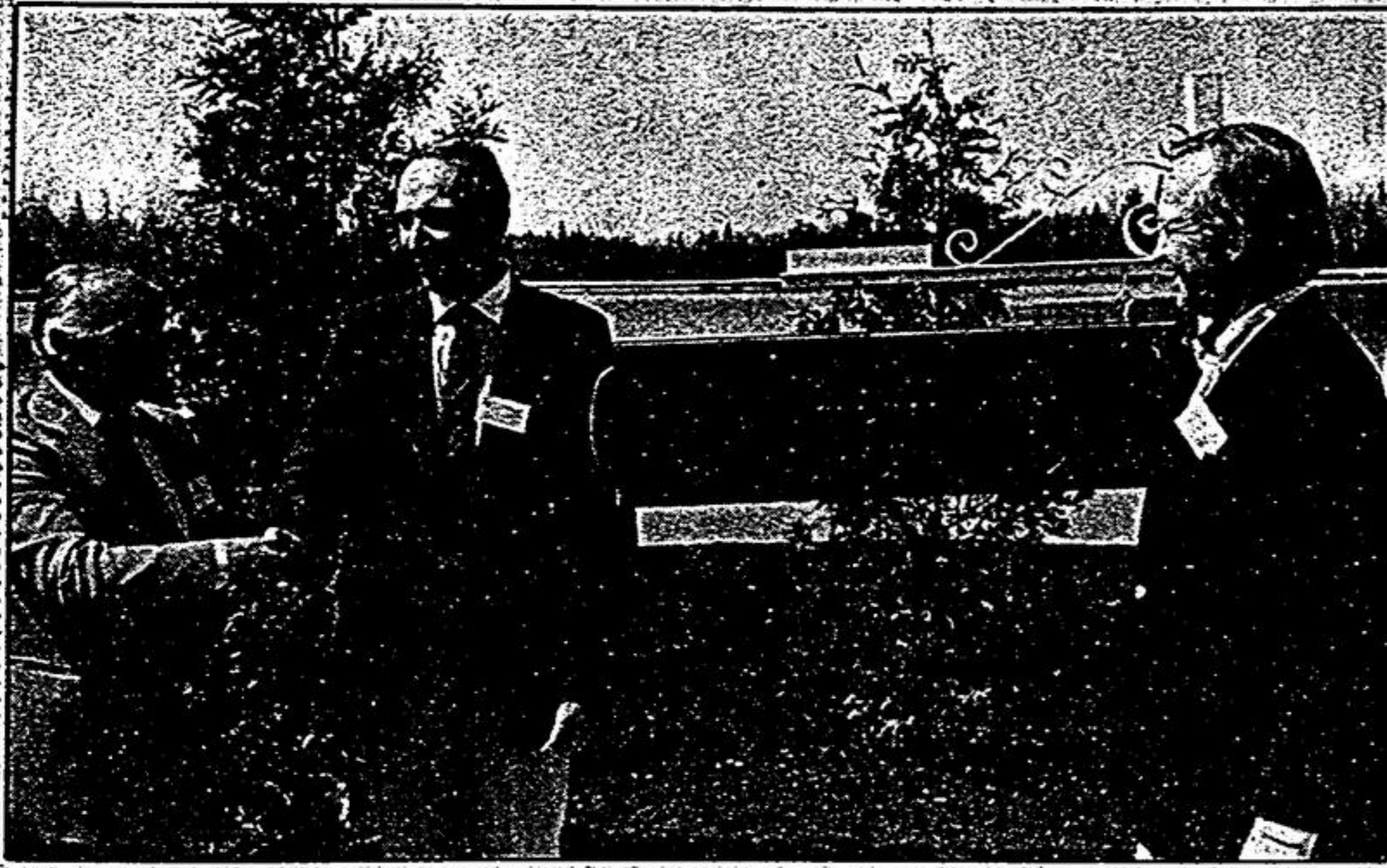


A dream come true

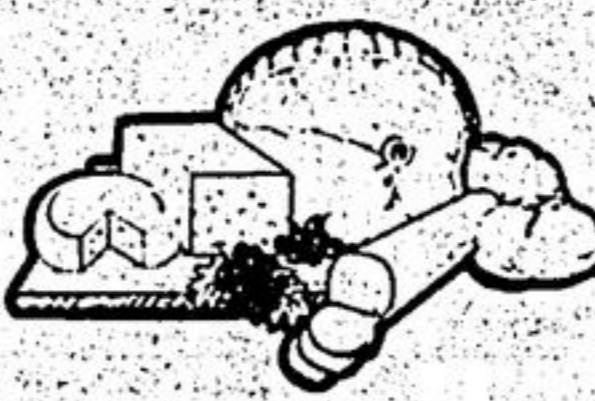
