vincial competition in Hamilton at the end of April.

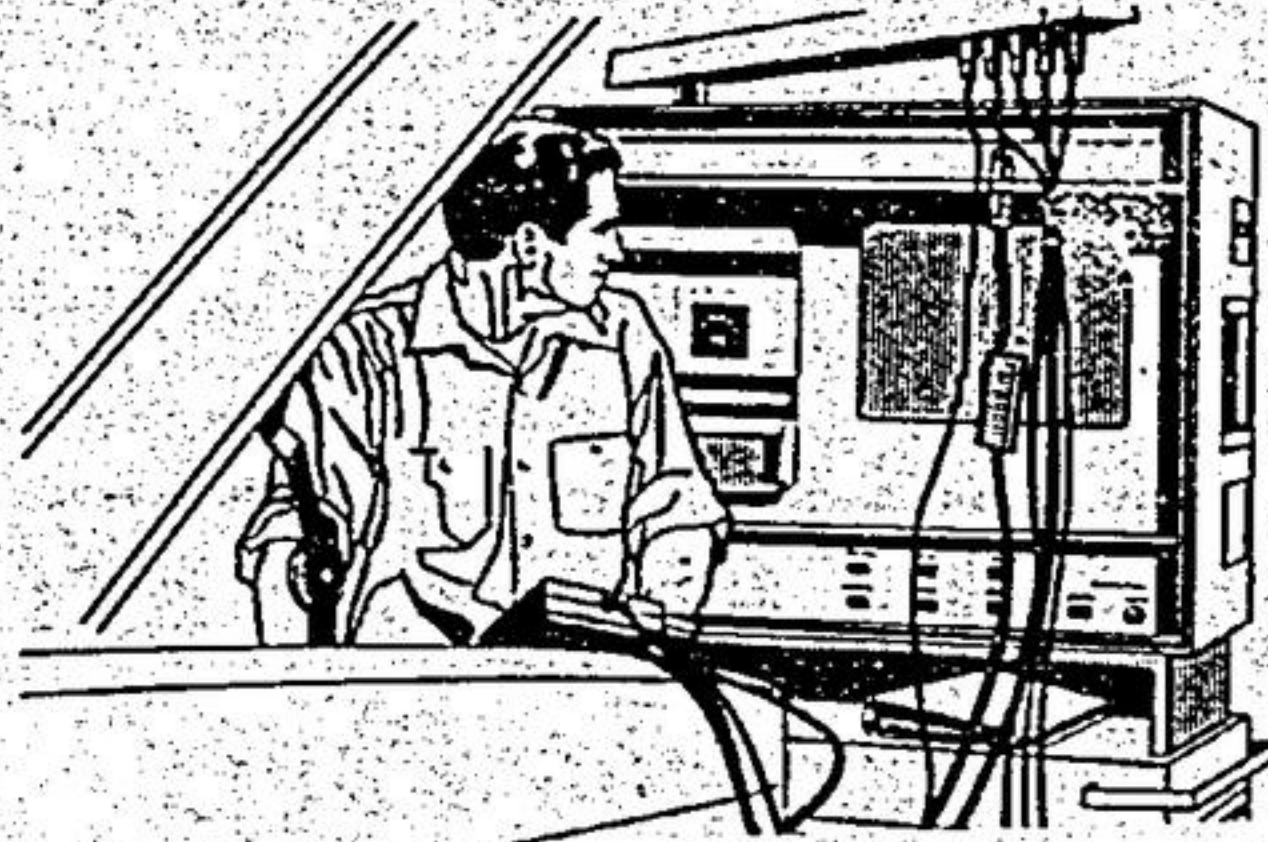
She placed third overall. Last week, she attended the national competition, which was held in Calgary. She came back to Markham with, once again, third prize.
