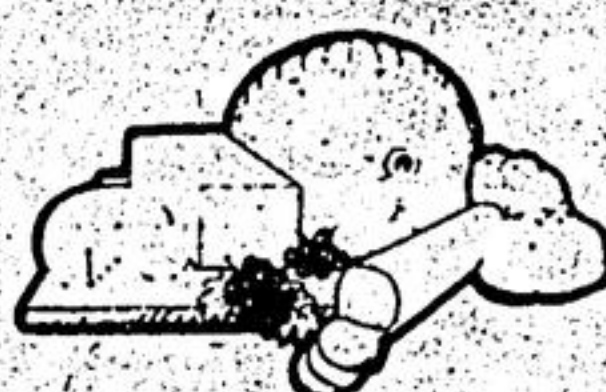

Busy year for Home Support

The annual meeting of Home Support Services, Town of Whitchurch-Stouffville reflected on accomplishments for the year April 1, 1985 to March 31, 1986.

The report was presented by the Co-ordinator Jean Anderson. Mrs Anderson praised the contributions of her predecessor, Betty Courage. "She contributed a great deal to the program," she said, "without her caring effort, Home Support Services would not be where it is today."

The organization has about 20 active volunteers. These people participated in 1,328 direct client assignments including local and longer-distance drives, visitations, errands and yard work.

During the winter, four Seniors took part in a swim program at Slater's Pool, Vandorf.

Home Support has a Special Projects Group that's active Monday afternoons. Activities include

crafts, movies and publishing a regular newsletter.

Mrs Anderson was loud in praise of Jim Rehill's Hand-In-Hand Program involving Grade 12 students from Stouffville Dist. Secondary School. These young people, assisted by co-ordinators Patty Hammond and Lucy Elliott, organized the completion of such tasks as snow-shovelling, yard work and providing transportation. "They were always cooperative," Mrs Anderson said, "never once refusing to provide assistance when asked."

Thirteen Home-Helpers call on residents in the community and assist them with household chores they can no longer do. During the past year, they put in an average of 670 hours a month for a total of 3,970 assignments.

Home-Helpers service all of Whitchurch-Stouffville, Mrs

Anderson explained, including such communities as Bethesda, Vandorf, Musselman's Lake, Ballantrae, Cherry Street, Pine Orchard and Stouffville.

At the annual meeting, Mrs Anderson thanked several people for assistance above and beyond the call of duty. These included Phyllis Madill, Dianne LeMotte, Margaret Meakes and Carole Langford.

Receipts during the year totaled \$3,088.80. Contributors follow: Town of Whitchurch-Stouffville-\$1,000; Stouffville Lions Club-\$500; McNeil Pharmaceutical-\$500; Recycling Depot-\$500; Stouffville Legion Ladies Auxiliary-\$200; Volunteer Drivers and Friends of Home Support-\$144.80; Stouffville Lioness Club-\$100; Beta Sigma Phi Sorority-\$94; Lemonville United Church Women-\$50.
