

Markham wins Junior golf title

Markham golfer Dave Pashko has done it again. Not content with the impressive 78 he shot to lead the field at the York Region high school tournament recently, Pashko did even better at the Georgian Bay competition.

High School (MDHS) student shot a 78 in the York event, then bettered that with a 71 (one under-par!) to lead all participants at Camp Borden's Circle Pine Golf and Country Club.

That performance, plus a 75 by 16-year-old Jim Stevenson (the 1985 Georgian Bay champ), helped

MDHS win the Junior title for the second straight year. Darryl May and Kyle O'Brien shot 85s to round out the squad. Their 316 total beat all Junior and Senior teams.

"I was anticipating they'd be amongst the top three teams," said coach Murray Everett. "But I didn't think they'd lead the pack. It (the team's performance) was just outstanding."

Everett had special praise for Pashko's performance, noting "this

lad has shown the greatest potential in my two decades of coaching golf here. To shoot one under-par at age 16 is just phenomenal."

The 16-year-old Wooten Way resident has been golfing six years, and among the trophies he's collected is the Junior championship at the Toronto Board of Trade.

Pashko and Stevenson are almost fanatical golfers, hitting the course every day no matter what the weather. Both are aiming for spots at the Ontario and Canadian Junior

amateur championships.

Markham's Senior team didn't fare as well as the Juniors. Brian Hogan, Peter Bryniawsky (who's earned a golf scholarship), Jason Wood and Mike Bryniawsky managed to place fifth overall.

"They just got off to a slower start," coach Everett recalled. "I have a feeling that if they all went back to fundamentals, it would increase their consistency. It was their inconsistency that was the problem."

Williams grabs 3rd place

The way things have been going the past few seasons, Greg Williams will soon be the best known motorcycle hillclimber of Markham's three-member Williams clan.

The 22-year-old 14th Ave. resident, the defending 500-cc world champion, continued his drive to keep the title with a third last weekend at York, Pennsylvania.

Greg finished just 12/1000s of a second out of second place, but said "I think I was outridden. I got a little anxious on the second ride and got a bit too much air on the first jump. That let him (the second-place finisher) sneak past me."


Williams has never finished lower than second in the overall season standings. Currently he's in second, just two points out of top spot.

Meanwhile, 26-year-old Wade continues to win the ongoing battle in the 750-cc division with family patriarch John, 47.

Wade drove his Honda STP Special to eighth spot — two places ahead of his father, a five-time world champion.

The next two competitions are crucial for John. He's currently somewhere around 14th in the world standings, but must do well enough to move into the top 12.

That gives him the right to compete in the prestigious U.S. Nationals.
