Markham hosts its first-ever Trade and Travel Show next week.

A clinic is being held next week in the Central Court of Markham Place at Don Mills Rd. and Steeles Ave. East.

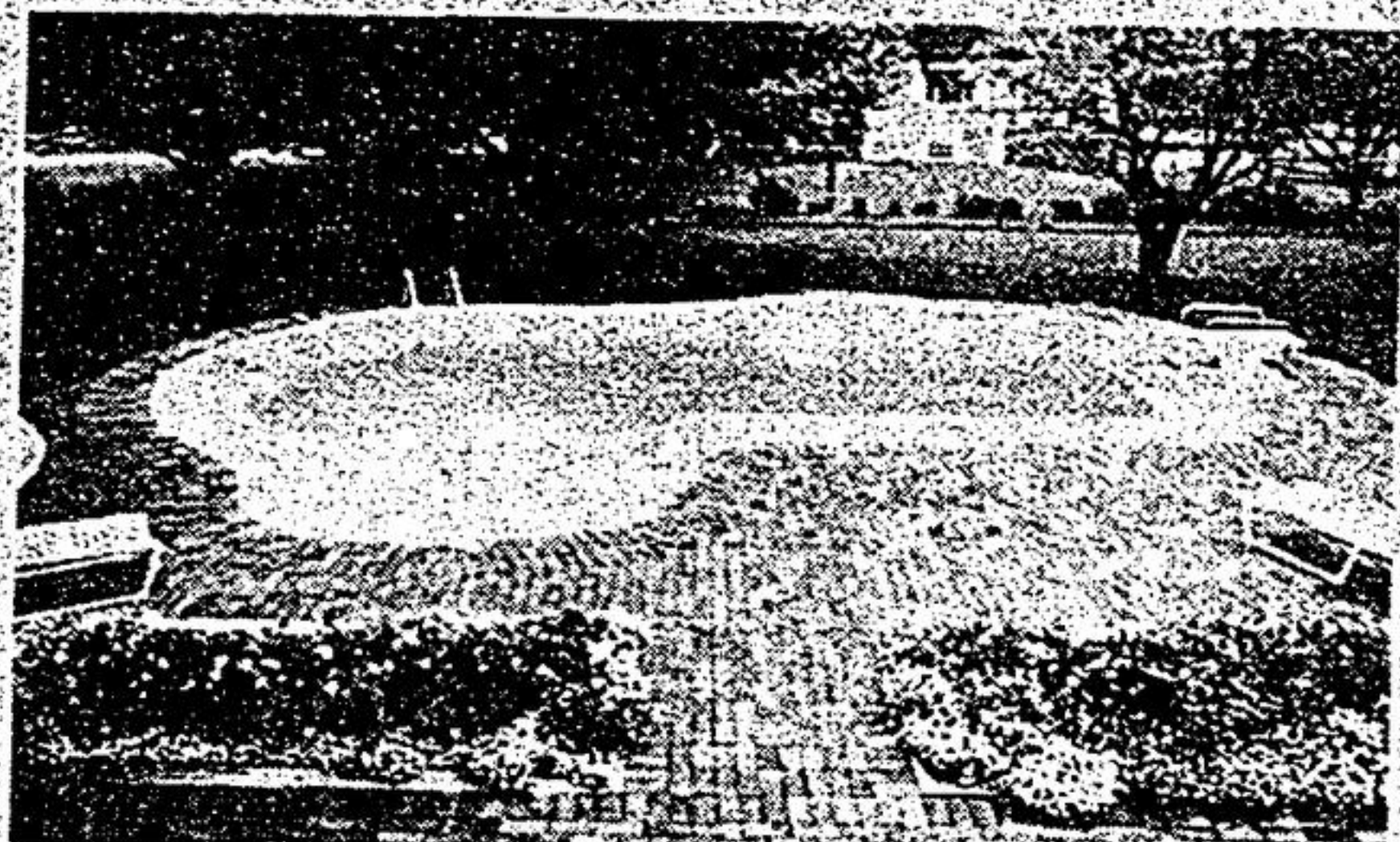
The clinic takes place Thursday, June 19 from 5:30 p.m. until 8:30 p.m.
