

Winning record

Still, no one can complain about

the squad's season to date. It's just the second loss in 15 games. The other was a 10-4 decision to Newmarket.

Five unearned Newmarket runs made the difference there. Robert Crawford had three RBIs, while Waldron had three hits, Waggott and Garren Traill two apiece. Earlier Markham had won the two clubs' first encounter 10-4.

Another close contest saw the locals shave Thornhill 6-5, with Crawford, Waggott, Shawn Dougherty, Peter Fraser, Mike Whalen and Paul Tatem scoring.

Markham's other recent contest was an easy 21-8 trashing of Bolton, a team the locals battled again Thursday night (results not available in time for the Weekender).

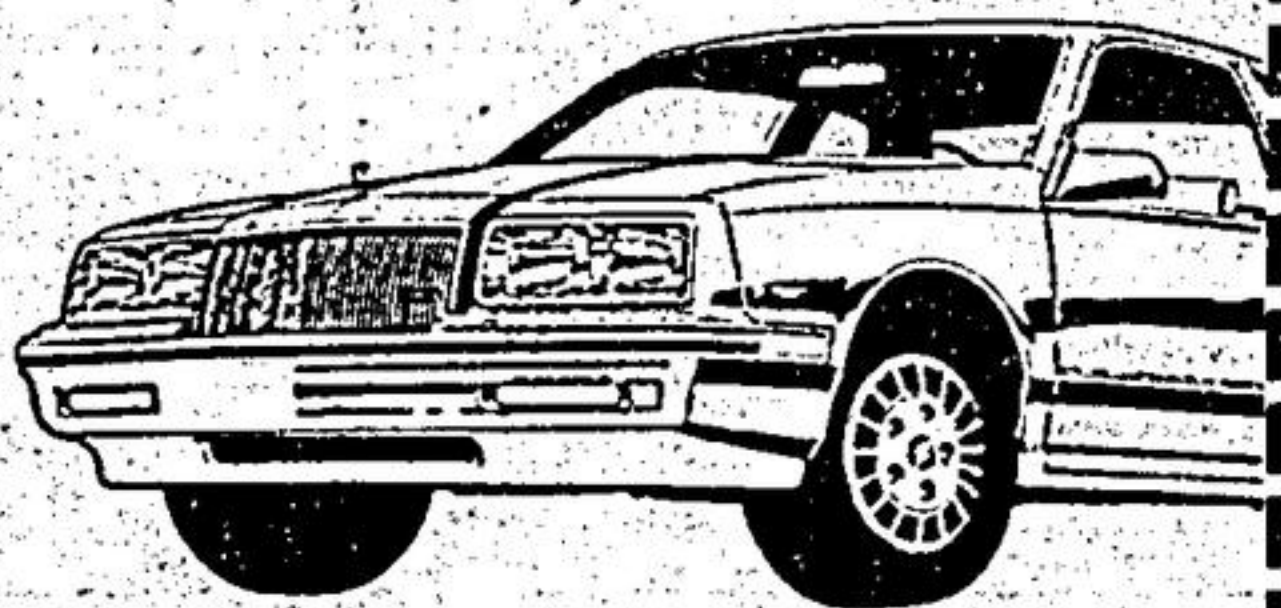
