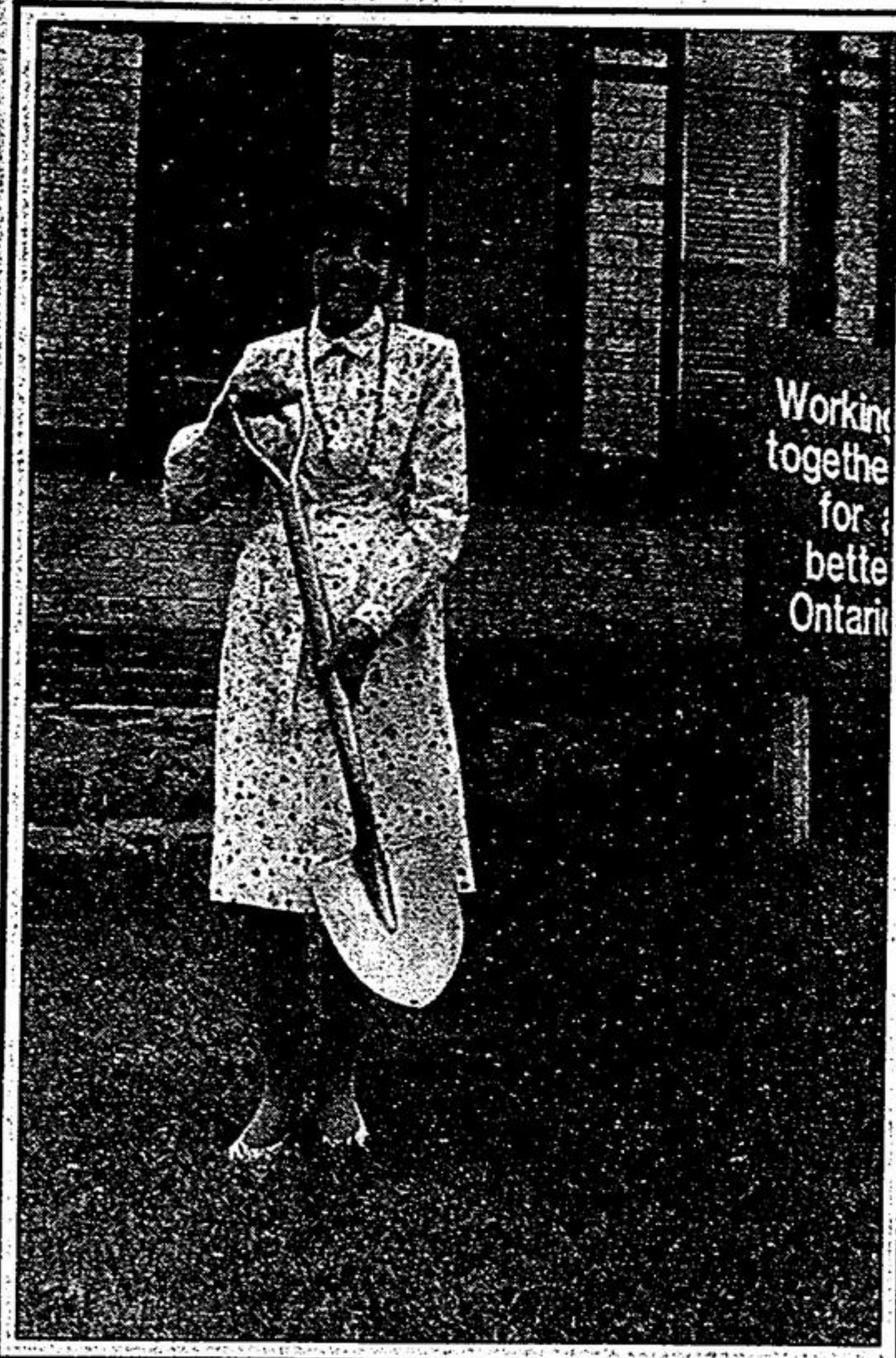


## Retired Uxbridge librarian 'honored' to turn sod for township's \$1 million library expansion project

Agnus Arbuckle, who served as Uxbridge's librarian between 1963-77, returned to the downtown landmark July 9 to officially break ground for a \$1 million library addition. "I was really quite honored," she said of the invitation extended on behalf of the Uxbridge Library Board. Municipal and provincial officials were also on hand to help launch the long-awaited project, which includes the

construction of an elevator, enlarged children and adult collection areas, plus multi-purpose and audio visual rooms. The new building — scheduled for completion in 1987 — is financially assisted by a \$492,500 provincial grant from the Ministry of Citizenship and Culture.
