A fun place

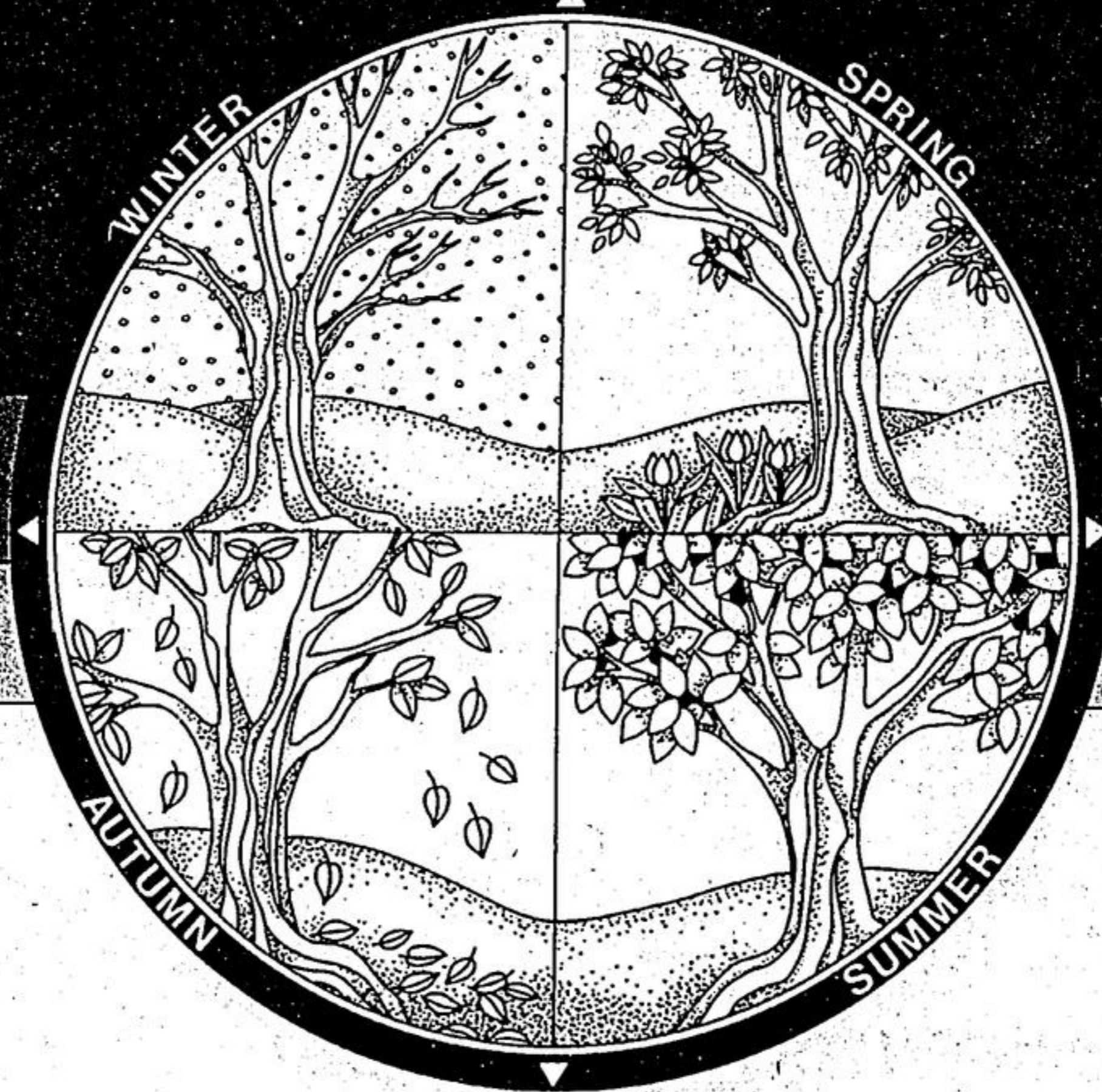
