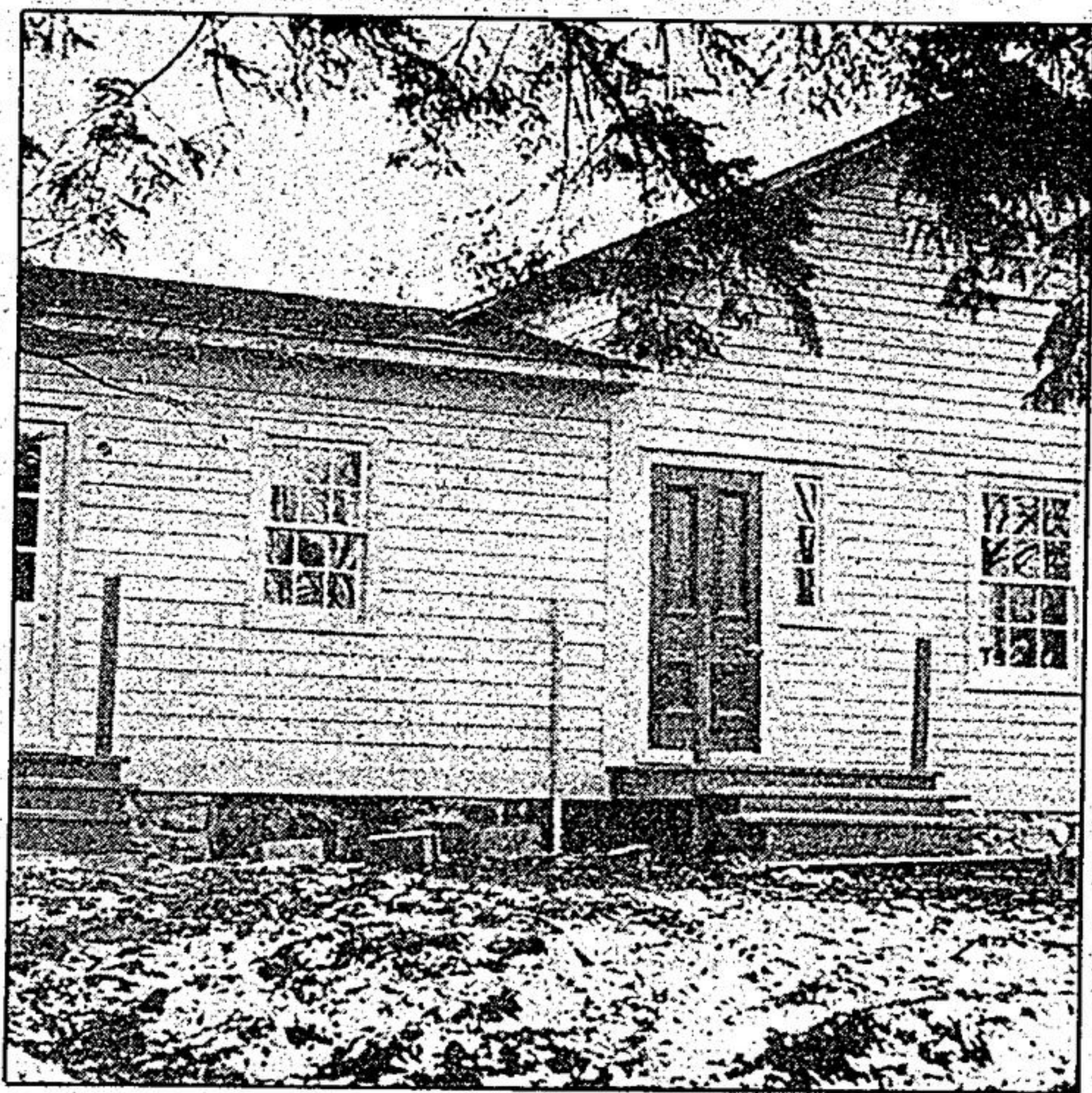


### Name that Building

Weaving, candle-making and rug-hooking demonstrations are just some of the events planned for Pickering Museum Village's second annual craft festival and sale.

Everything from pottery and quilts to Lorraine Chien's hand-crafted teddy bears will be available tomorrow (July 27) from noon to 5 p.m.

The restored 19th century village — featuring homes, barns, a blacksmith shop, hotel and church — is located on Hwy. 7 in Greenwood, three kilometres east of Brock Road.

Museum visitors also have access to a large picnic area near the banks of Duffin's Creek.

Regular admission, including parking, is \$5 per family; adults, \$2 each; senior citizens and students, \$1.25; children age 5 to 12, 75 cents; and pre-schoolers, free.
