# Police seek suspects

Durham Regional Crime Stoppers is asking for the public's assistance in identifying the persons responsible for break and enters that are occurring in the Region of Durham at all times of the day and night.

Two recent daytime B&Es in the Scugog and Uxbridge areas netted thieves more than \$50,000 in jewellery, VCRs, guns, silver-

ware, cash and personal property.

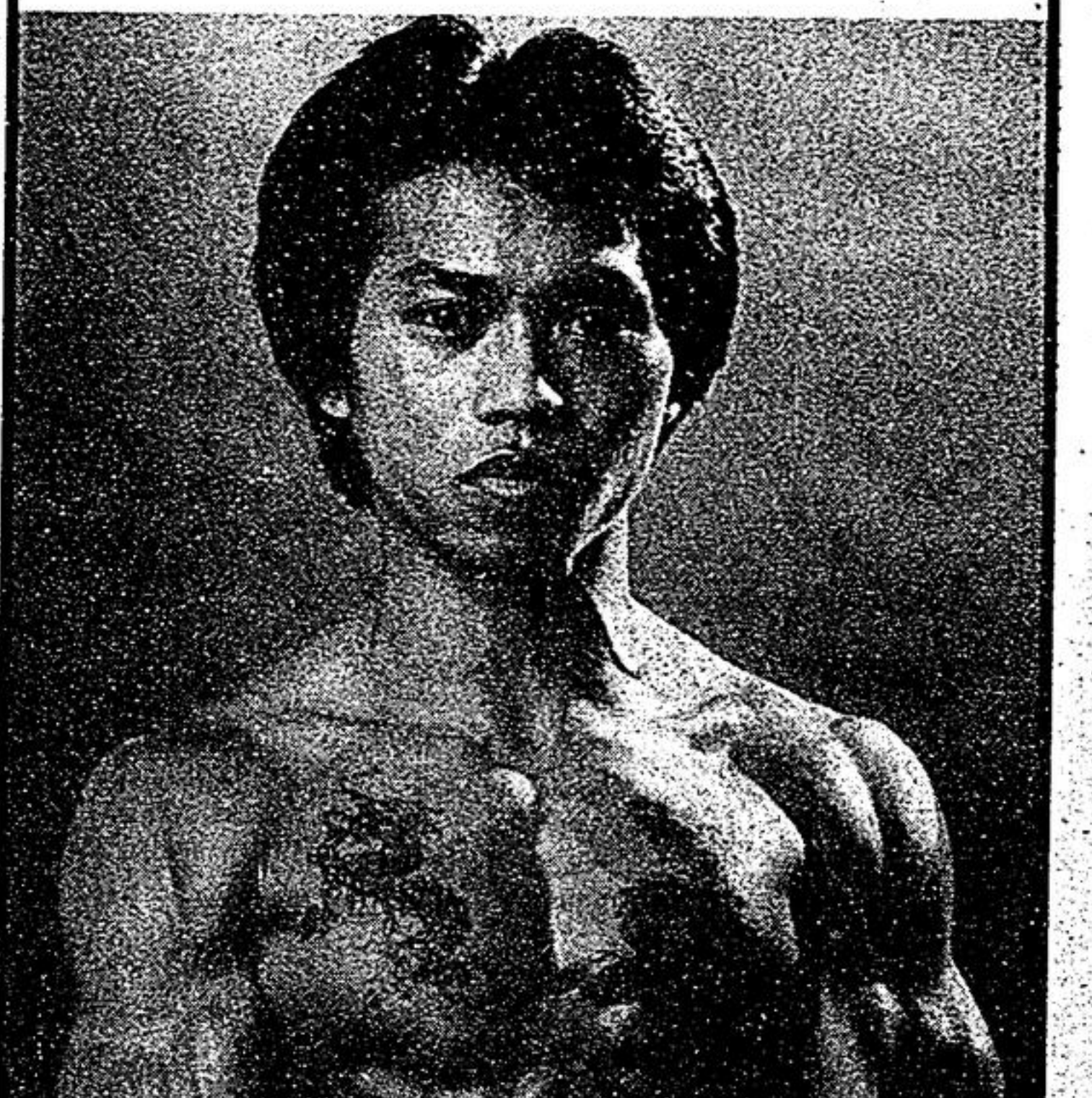
