Markham Hydro calls them white phase faults. But most people know them as blown fuses. Hydro workers were trying to locate a break in the power lines at approximately 7:17 p.m. Friday when a switch blew, blacking out power in Unionville homes for several minutes. Another blackout occurred Saturday morning, around 10:15 a.m., as workers tried to pinpoint the underground fault discovered the night before. A Hydro spokesman said the break in the line was likely caused by the severe lightning flashes on Friday. The problem has since been located and repaired.
