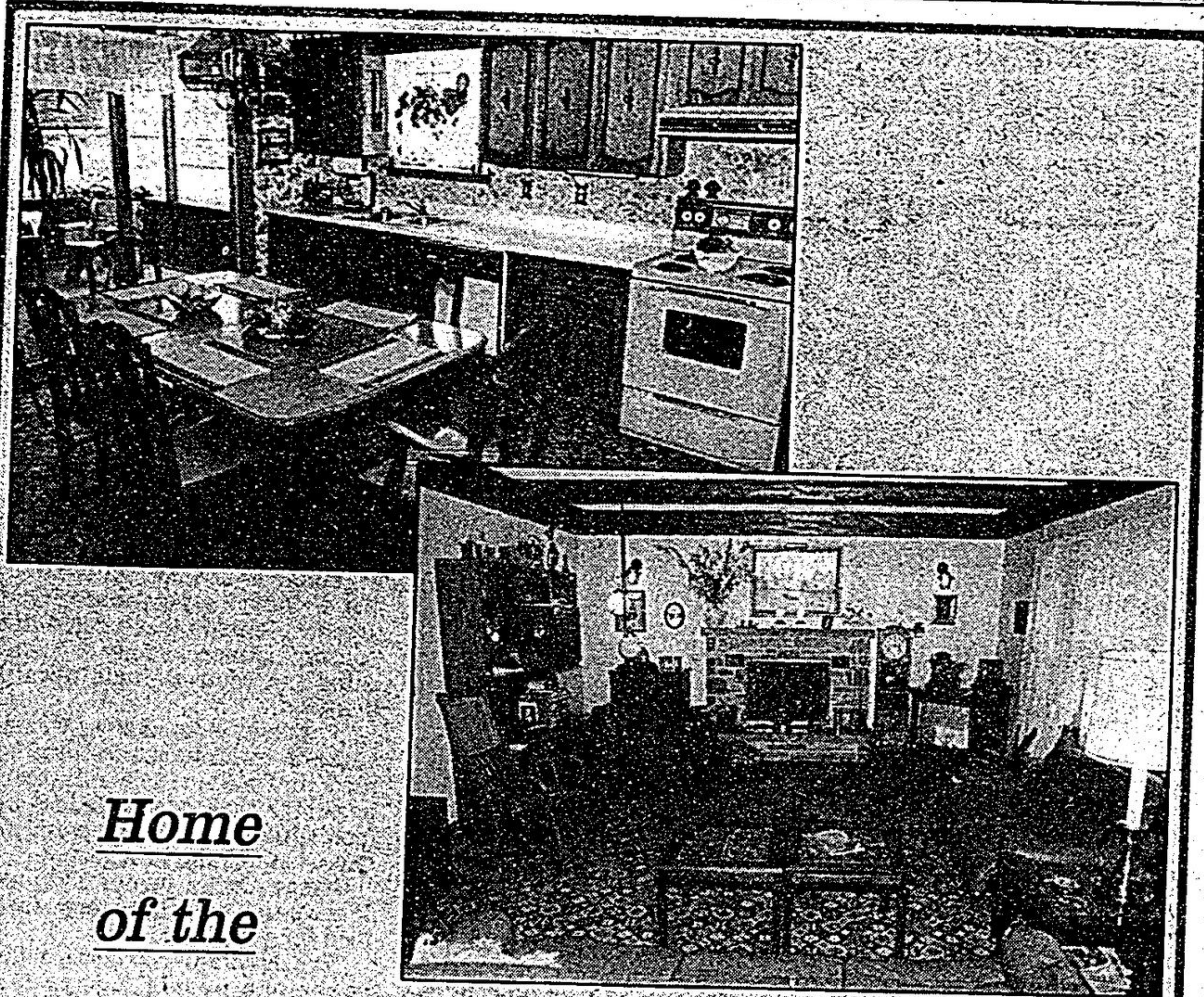


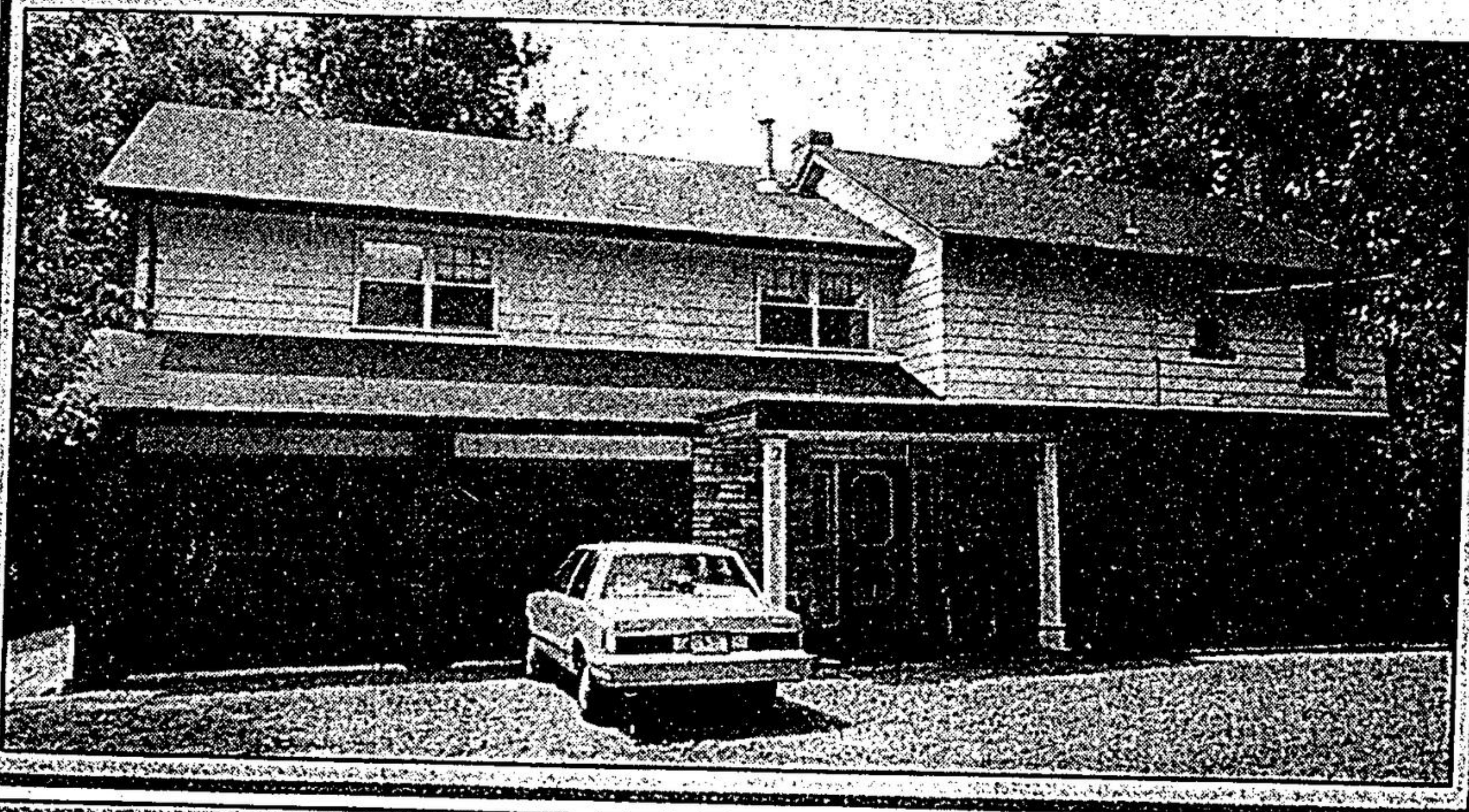

CABLE RATES INCREASE: On Sept. 1, 1986 Classicomm's basic cable rates will increase from \$9.60 to \$10.75 per month. The rate for additional outlets will also increase from \$3.25 to \$3.50 per month. The CRTC approved the increase on July 18, 1986. Stewart Coxford, president of Classicomm, said the rate increases result from additional operating expenses and up-grading of services.
