Lone male robs bank

Toronto and Regional Crime Stoppers is seeking the assistance of the public in an effort to solve a bank robbery.

On Saturday, April 26th, 1986 at about 4:00 p.m., a lone male gunman entered the Canada Trust situated at 4681 Hwy 7 East in Unionville. He climbed over the rope barriers, walked over to one of the tellers and handed her a hold-up note which stated, "Give me all your money." He then produced a handgun from his waistband pointing it at the teller and repeated the demand verbally.

He received an undisclosed amount of money and fled on foot.

The party is described as a white male in his twenties, six-foot tall, skinny build, dark colored, shoulder-length hair and at the time, had a noticeable scab on the left side of his face which was partly covered by mirrored sunglasses.

He was wearing a black baseball cap with a Q-107 emblem on the front, a black T-shirt, faded jeans and jean jacket.

A re-enactment of this crime will be shown on CITY TV Thursday during the 6 p.m. and 10 p.m. news.

Other appeals for help in identifying this criminal will be made by Crime Stoppers on radio stations, local newspapers, Cable stations and CKVR TV in Barrie.

If you have any information about this crime or any other serious case, call Crime Stoppers. As a caller, you never have to identify yourself and you never have to appear in court. If an arrest is made as a result of the information you have provided to Crime Stoppers, you then become eligible for a cash reward of up to \$1,000.

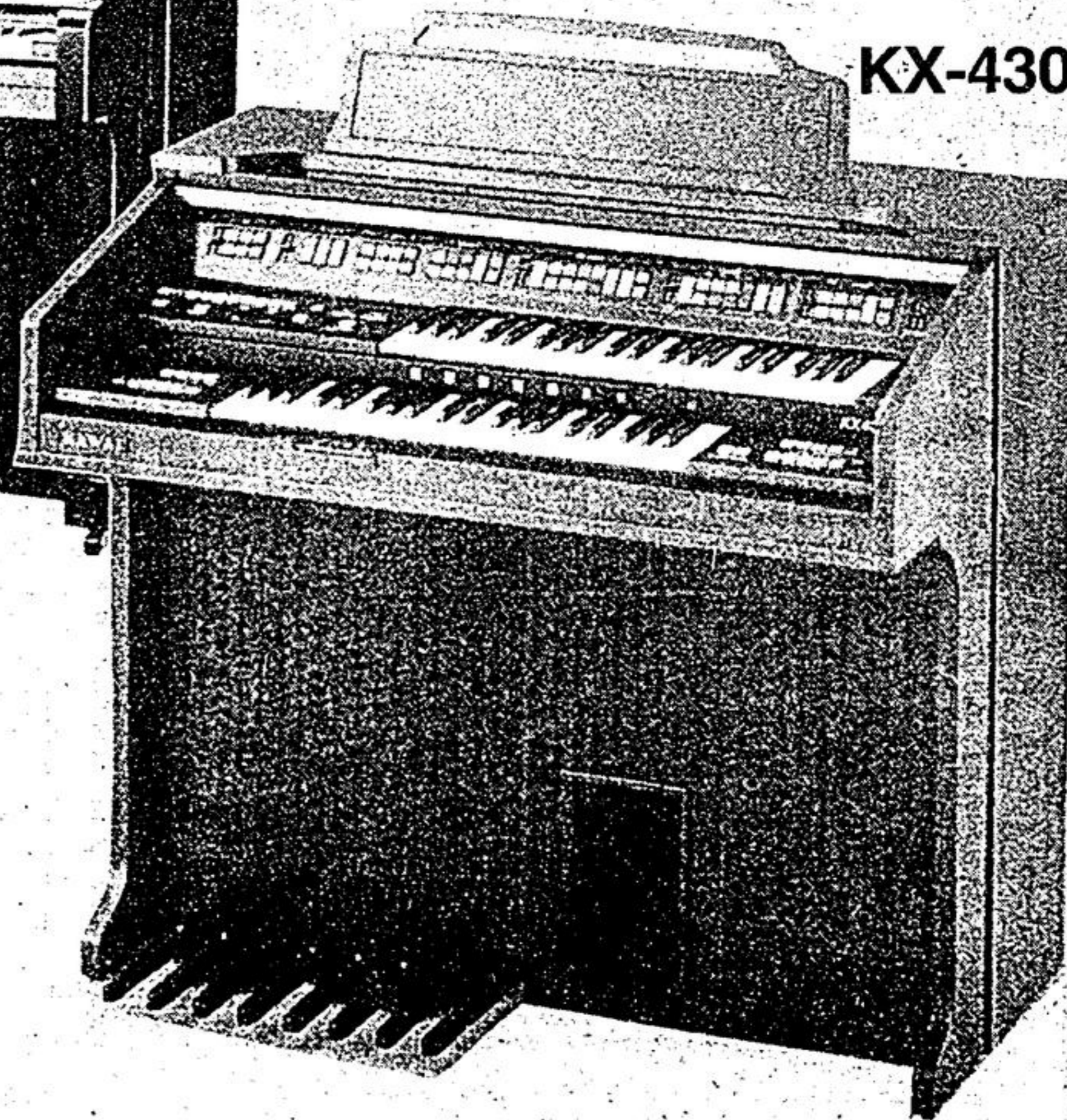
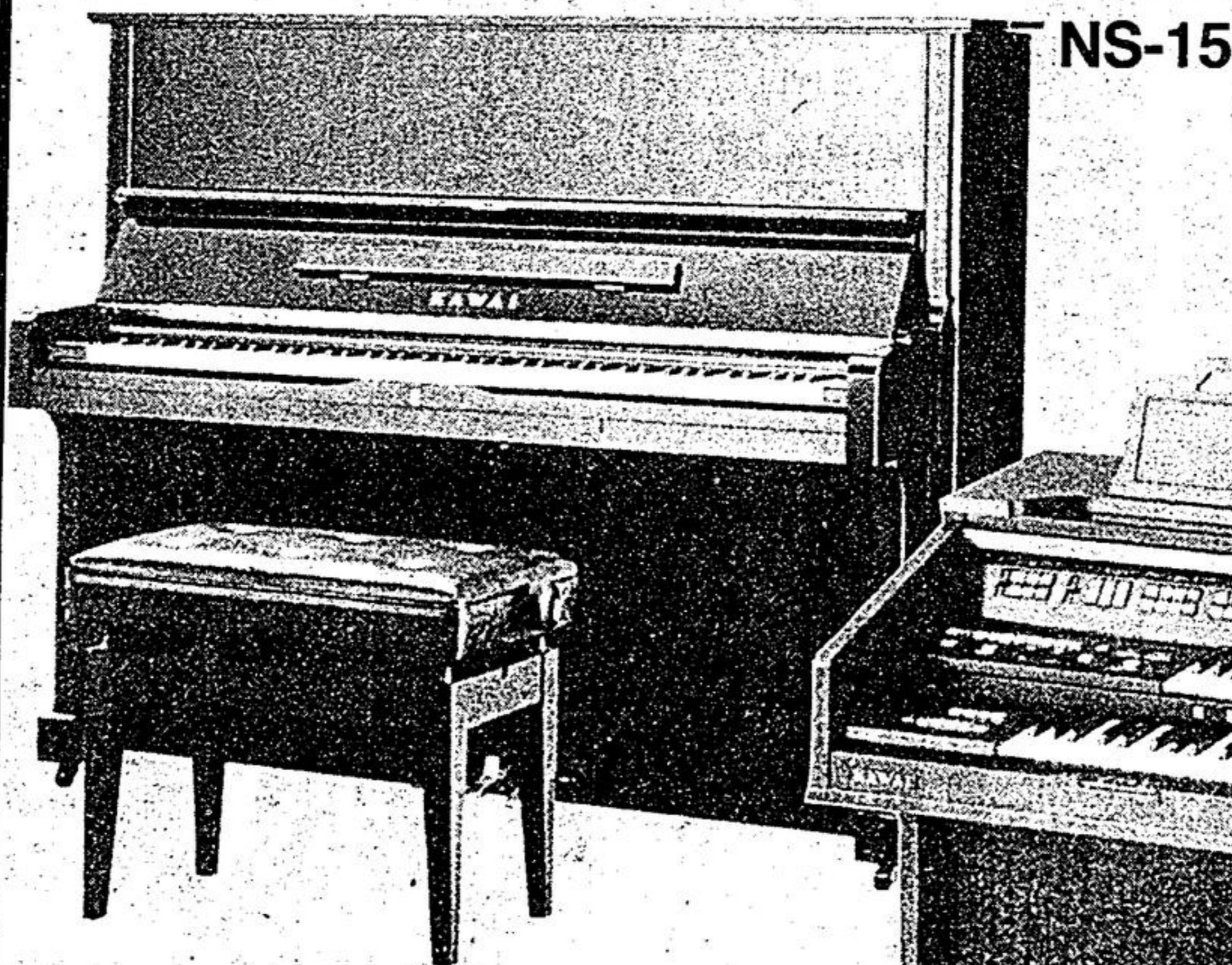
