

**EXPROPRIATIONS ACT**  
**NOTICE OF APPLICATION FOR APPROVAL TO EXPROPRIATE LAND**

IN THE MATTER OF an application by The Corporation of the Town of Markham for approval to expropriate land being part of Lot 11, Concession 4, Town of Markham, Regional Municipality of York, being Part 1, on draft plan of expropriation known as Job No. 86-233 for the purpose of sites for the establishment and carrying on of industries and of industrial operations and uses incidental thereto.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that application has been made for approval to expropriate the land described as follows:  
Part of Lot 11, Concession 4, Town of Markham, Regional Municipality of York, being Part 1, on draft plan of expropriation Job No. 86-233.

Any owner of lands in respect of which notice is given who desires an inquiry into whether the taking of such land is fair, sound and reasonably necessary in the achievement of the objectives of the expropriating authority shall so notify the approving authority in writing.

(a) In the case of a registered owner, served personally or by registered mail within thirty days after he is served with the notice, or when he is served by publication, within thirty days after the first publication of the notice;

(b) In the case of an owner who is not a registered owner, within thirty days after the first publication of the notice.

NOTES:  
1. The Expropriations Act provides that,  
(a) where an inquiry is requested, it shall be conducted by an inquiry officer appointed by the Attorney General.  
(b) the inquiry officer,  
(i) shall give every party to the inquiry an opportunity to present evidence and argument and to examine and cross-examine witnesses, either personally or by his counsel or agent, and  
(ii) may recommend to the approving authority that a party to the inquiry be paid a fixed amount for his costs of the inquiry not to exceed \$200 and the approving authority may in its discretion order the expropriating authority to pay such costs forthwith.

2. "owner" and "registered owner" are defined in the Act as follows:  
"owner" includes a mortgagee, tenant, execution creditor, a person entitled to a limited estate or interest in land, a committee of the estate of a mentally incompetent person or of a person incapable of managing his affairs, and a guardian, executor, administrator or trustee in whom land is vested;  
"registered owner" means an owner of land whose interest in the land is defined and whose name is specified in an instrument in the proper land registry or sheriff's office, and includes a person shown as a tenant of land on the last revised assessment roll.

3. The expropriating authority, each owner who notifies the approving authority that he desires a hearing in respect of the lands intended to be expropriated and any owner added as a party by the inquiry officer are parties to the inquiry.



**Trillium Horse Show**  
**Mini-Olympics**

Michelle Bonte, a 23-year-old equestrian jumper who lived out her personal dream as a judge at the 1984 Olympic Games in Los Angeles, is continuing her passion for horsemanship.

She is bringing her dream one step further with the debut of an equestrian mini-Olympics in Stouffville, Sunday, Sept. 7.  
Her Bedrock Stables Trillium Horse Show is a recently sanctioned event in the Trillium Circuit (one level below National). Trillium is the second-last level of difficulty for young riders on the road to international competition.

Granted status by the Canadian Equestrian Federation in March, Bedrock Stables is one of five such events annually in the area.

Up to 100 competitors will take part. The event will feature some of the best horse and rider talent in Ontario.
