

Scarborough men die in spectacular Uxbridge Township collision

Two Scarborough men were killed Friday in a two-vehicle collision on Durham Region Road 21, west of Conc. 7 in Uxbridge Township. According to Durham Regional Police, a 1985 Chrysler carrying driver Robert Barlow, 30, and 28-year-old Colin Hutton was westbound on Durham 21 when it suddenly veered across the centre line and was struck on the passenger side by an eastbound 1987 Dodge driven by Ann Cramm, 48, of Port Perry. Both Barlow

and Hutton were both later pronounced dead at area hospitals. Cramm was rushed to Sunnybrook Medical Centre, where she remains in serious condition with internal injuries. 




