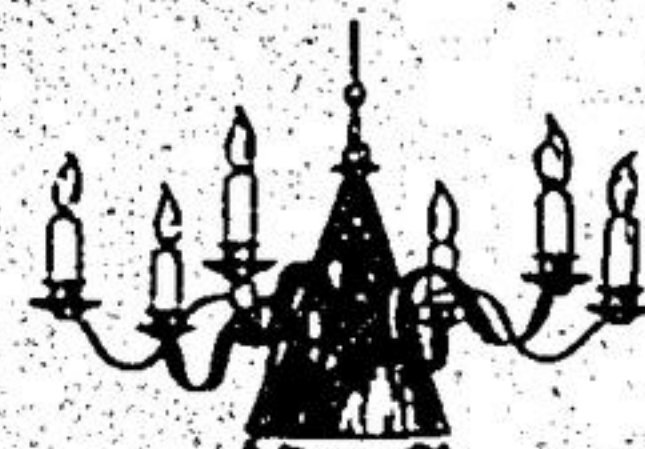
With 70 Big and Little Sister matches and over 20 young girls waiting for a Big Sister, the

money donated from the 10 Km. Run will be used toward activities held for the Little Sisters and ongoing training and expansion of services to the youth in York Region.

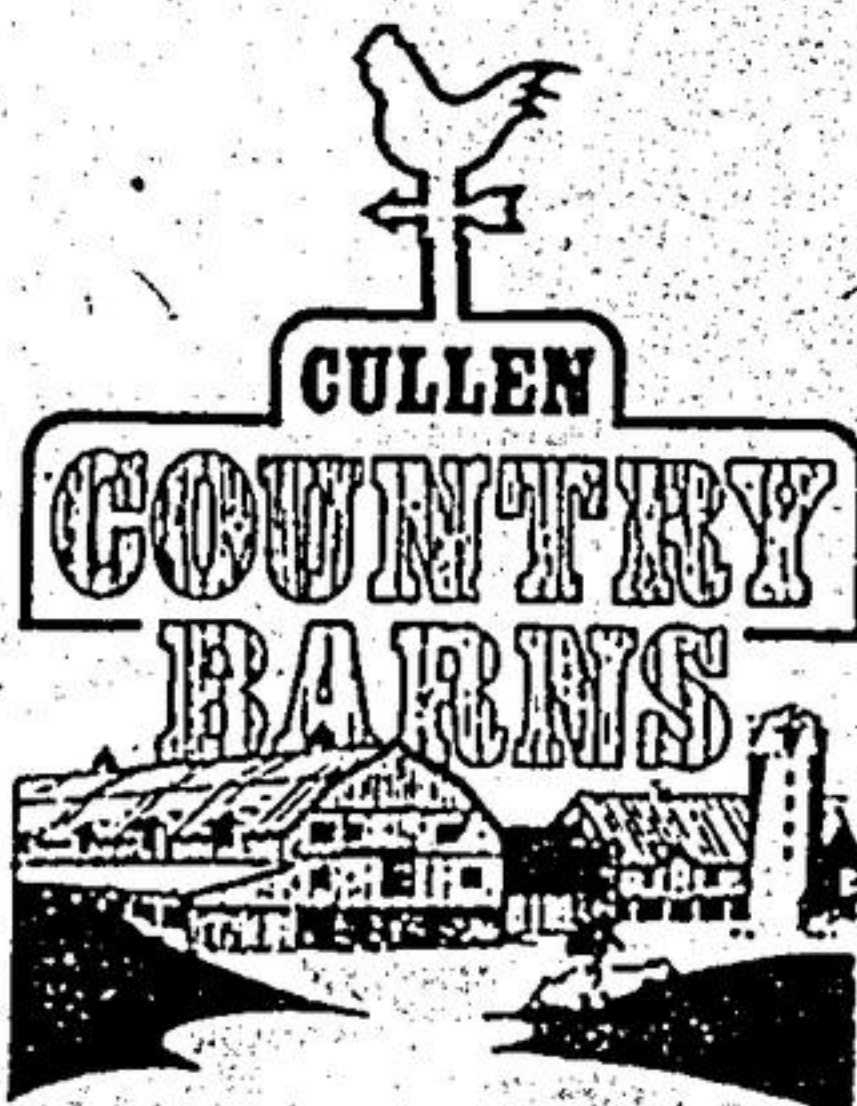
