Baha'is celebrate peace

To the Baha'is of Markham, next week, (Sept. 15-21,) is a particularly special one during the United Nations designated Year of Peace.

For Baha'is around the world, peace through the unity of mankind has always been their focus of life and activities since the early days of their faith in 1844.

This U.N. Year of Peace, however, has increased the awareness of peace related activities at all levels of society, and here in Markham and Thornhill the Baha'is have been involved in these growing activities as well.

At the heart of their peace directed efforts is a comprehensive statement on peace written by the Universal House of Justice, the chief administrative body of

the world wide Baha'i Community.

Since this statement was released Oct. 24, 1985 at the time of the 40th anniversary of the establishment of the United Nations, Baha'is around the world have been meeting with government leaders at local, national, and international levels to present them with this unique document on the theme of unity and peace.

On Aug. 18, the Baha'i in Markham had the opportunity to present this statement, "The Promise of World Peace" to Mayor Carole Bell and Markham Council at a council meeting.

At that time, the Baha'i community also requested that, in recognition of Sept. 16 as International Day of Peace, the week of September 15-21 be proclaimed as Markham Peace Week. The Coun-

cil acted on this request and the proclamation is to be published.

Throughout next week many activities are taking place sponsored by people and organizations ardently striving for peace. Amongst these activities was a reception which takes place Tuesday at the Bayview Golf and Country Club sponsored by the Baha'is.

Guests representing networks of individuals and groups working for peace at local and national levels will hear Jack Lenz, composer and musician, speak on the theme of "Peace and a New World Order".

The Baha'i community is confident that this week is a symbol of the strengthening commitment, on the part of many, to the knowledge that not only is peace possible, but indeed inevitable.
