**Girl Guide leaders needed in Markham**

With 1,000 participants, the Markham Girl Guide division is stretched to its limit and needs more leaders to keep up with the tremendous growth in this area.

The Rouge Valley division is a new geographical area which consists of Markham, Unionville and Milliken. The Markham area used to belong to the York South division which takes in a large area including Thornhill and as far as west of Yonge St.

The new division was created because this area is growing so quickly.

Division Commissioner June Williams said Rouge Valley includes 39 units (of Brownies, Guides, Pathfinders and Rangers), and 100 leaders.

"We all have waiting lists (of interested girls), but we don't have new leaders. We have to maintain a ratio of leaders to girls," she said, explaining that the waiting lists will continue growing unless new Guiders can be recruited.

Leaders responsibilities include being available for one meeting each week with the group as well as district meetings and training programs which come up periodically.

Guiding activities include arts and crafts, hiking, and special camping weekends. Special talents are not required of Guiders although they are an asset.

Guiders should have a positive outlook, a love of fun, a sense of humor and the ability to work with a team.

The girls range in age from six — where they start as Brownies — to teenage Rangers who have to be at least 15 years old.

"A lot of leaders join because they want their daughters to be involved, but most Guiders find out they're in it for themselves."

"You meet such super women, these people keep you in guiding long after your daughter has left," Mrs. Williams said.
