4th annual sale

Step into the past

Celebrate Thanksgiving weekend with a trip into Canada's past at the fourth annual antique show at Markville Shopping Centre.

The Remembrance of Things Past show begins with a preview on Wednesday, Oct. 8 from 6 to 9:30 p.m. and continues during mall hours on Thursday, Friday and Saturday.

Expect to find a wide variety of furniture in sophisticated and country styles. Sandra Halpern, organizer of the show said the amount of furniture shown at

Markville is unique among antique shows.

"Most antique shows don't have room for furniture," she said.

Also featured at the show will be Canadian pressed glass, sterling silver, costume jewelry and European china.

Dealers will also be showing rare colored lamps, a Group of Seven painting, cooking utensils, clocks and grain scales which date back to 1880.

Ms. Halpern said cut glass and sterling dresser sets are becoming very popular with collectors.

She added that paisley patterns are also going to gain popularity.

About 37 dealers from Ottawa, Montreal, London and Sarnia, as well as nearby antique sellers will be on hand.

On Thursday and Friday from 6:30 to 8:30 and on Saturday from 1 to 4 p.m. a representative of the Royal Ontario Museum will identify antique treasures free of charge.

"There's something for advanced collectors and for the unknowing curious," Ms. Halpern said.
