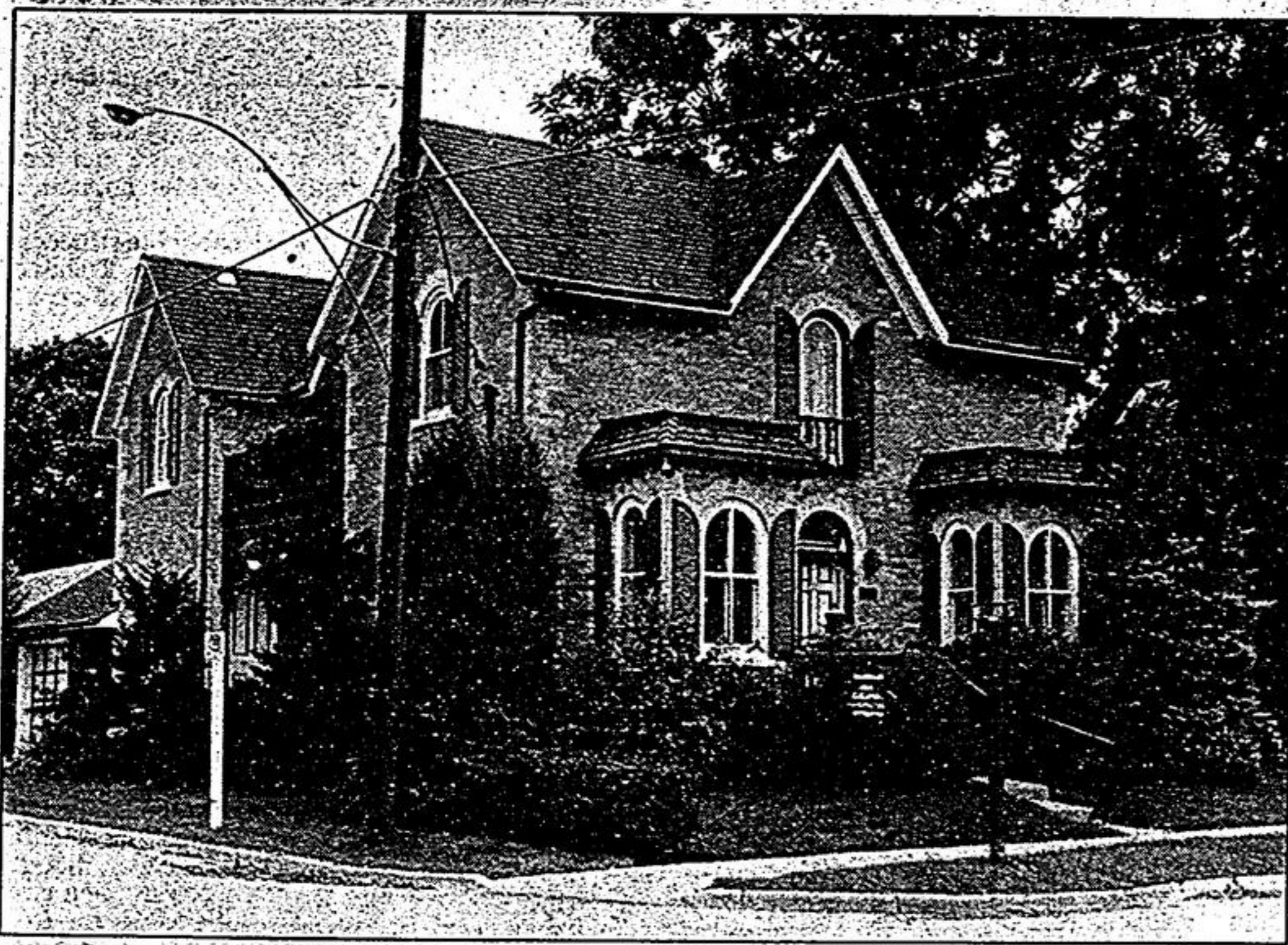


Tour of Homes
